Our goal is to create a safe and secure environment for your little ones so that they love their experience from the very beginning.

AGE 2 - PRE-K

Kids Ministry meets on Sunday mornings, all year long. Kids Pre-K - Grade 5 also meets Wednesday nights September - April.

TO REQUEST PRAYER

- Connect Card on Sunday Morning Each Sunday morning during worship, you will have an opportunity to fill out a Connect Card with your prayer request. A team of people will pray for your request during the week.
- Enter a Prayer Request on the Friendship Church website at friendshipmn.org/prayer
- **Elder Prayer** Friendship Church has Elders who are available to pray for healing and anoint you with oil as James 5 explains. If you are ready to take the next step of faith towards healing, please contact the Elders at friendshipmn.org/prayer
- **Prayer Wall** enter a prayer request on the Friendship App and pray for those in need on the prayer wall.

JOIN A PRAYER TEAM

There are many people in need of prayer. By joining a prayer team, you are committing to honor confidentiality regarding the requests.

- Sunday Morning Prayer Ministers Pray for others at the end of a service (usually a 15-minute time commitment, once a month). Prayer Ministers are needed at both Prior Lake and Shakopee Campuses.
- Connect Card Prayer Team Pray weekly for four to six prayer requests that we receive via Connect Cards on Sunday mornings.
- **Prayer Chain** As a member of the prayer chain, you will receive email updates of prayer requests from our church family.
