

FRIENDSHIP CHURCH PRIVACY POLICY

Friendship Church of Prior Lake and Shakopee, MN (Friendship Church) respects your privacy and is committed to protecting your personal information. This statement explains our policies and practices regarding the use and disclosure of your personal information by Friendship Church.

Because your use of websites owned by Friendship Church indicates your acceptance of the Friendship Church Privacy Policy, please review this Privacy Policy carefully. Please note that Friendship Church reviews and updates this Privacy Policy from time to time as needed without notice. Therefore, you should review the terms of this policy periodically to make sure that you are aware of how Friendship Church collects and uses personal information. By using this website, you consent to the collection and use of your personal information by Friendship Church as outlined below.

Note that Friendship Church cannot accept or create account information, or accept credit card payments, from individuals who are under 18 years of age. Parents and/or Guardians must create an account first, and then add family members under the age of 18 to their family account profile.

Information Collection and Use

Friendship Church is the sole owner of the information collected on this website. Friendship Church provides the application, forms, and programs to collect and manage this information.

We will not sell, rent, or trade personally identifiable information to anyone, and we will not disclose any collected information to others in ways other than what is disclosed in this statement.

We receive personally identifiable information including, but not limited to, your name, address, phone number, and email address. Once you register for an account and sign in to our services, you are not anonymous to us and we may receive and record information about your browser including IP address, cookie information and the page you requested.

Financial Transaction Information

Friendship Church does not accept or store any credit card information or bank account information. Friendship Church uses a third-party intermediary to perform any financial information collection and transaction processing. If you, as a User, perform a financial transaction with us or our intermediary, the intermediary must request information from you. This information includes but is not limited to credit card information or bank account information.

Our intermediary is solely a link in the distribution chain, and uses the information provided for the sole purpose of processing the transaction. We recommend Users read the Privacy Policy of this intermediary which can also be found on the payment page of a Friendship Church website.

Information Sharing and Disclosure
