TEAM BUDGETS/ADDITIONAL TOURNAMENTS

- Our program registration fee covers regular season events that are typically 5-6 total tournaments. Individual teams have the option to participate in more tournaments, if interested, with additional cost.

FACILITY USAGE & SAFETY INFORMATION

SCHOOL FACILITIES – Logan administration has provided building guidelines & safety items for our scheduled practices. Only coaches & players should access the building during scheduled practices. Parents can plan to drop off & pick up their child at each school location. Teams should not prop open any exterior doors.

BOYS & GIRLS CLUB FACILITIES – Safety guidelines for Boys & Girls Clubs of America allow registered players & approved coaches in our Club facilities for scheduled practices. Approved coaches verified upon entry at Club locations. Parents can plan to drop off & pick up their child when scheduled at a Club location.
