#### **Costa Rica Mission Team Update**

Thank you for your generosity as the team continues to raise funds for the mission trip to Limon Costa Rica! As our preparations continue, we are very appreciative of your gifts that make this mission opportunity possible. We are representatives of Mandan UMC in Central America, and your presence will be present as we minister to the people in Costa Rica! Please continue to pray for this mission trip that minister not only to the people of Limon, but also to each member of the team.

The final itinerary is tentative; however, we know that we will be assisting with Polar Blast VBS, leading a soccer camp, assembling school backpacks with items we will bring to Costa Rica, helping with harvest, painting and replacing doors and door frames at the church, extending a retaining wall and teaching first aid. Hands and Hearts for Jesus (HH4J) mission has missionaries that live in Limon and minister to people full time. Their leader, Sally, stresses the importance of each team learning about the culture of Limon, Costa Rica by providing time for tours to a jaguar rescue, chocolate and coffee factories.

Our team will need to provide funds for our projects, and these costs have yet to be determined. We will also pack items such as VBS snacks, school supplies, paint rollers, a first aid kit and other needed supplies.

School supplies will be needed for the children in Limon. The items below will be collected:

Eighteen thousand dollars have already been raised, and we are praiseful for these gifts! The initial estimate of \$22,000 may need to be adjusted to fulfill these needs. Our fundraising efforts will include coffee sales, the Costa Rica Coffee Counter between worship services in December, Jana's jelly donations and individual gifts. We are confident that by God's grace and provision, the goal will be met!
