

As our preparations continue, we are very appreciative of your gifts that make this mission opportunity possible. We are representatives of Mandan UMC in Central America, and your presence will be present as we minister to the people in Costa Rica! Please continue to pray for this mission trip that minister not only to the people of Limon, but also to each member of the team.

Our departure date is drawing closer, and we are excited as we prepare to set off for Limon. Our itinerary begins on January 13th as we leave Bismarck about 6:30 a.m. We will return on January 22nd at 9:30 p.m. The days in between are filled with first aid classes, soccer camp, painting, repairing the church, handing out back-to-school bags, VBS for all ages, picking produce and many other tasks. Additional time has been designated for tours, souvenir shopping and enjoying the beautiful Costa Rican beaches.
