If you applied for federal assistance with FEMA and need continued support after the July 1 deadline, FEMA specialists are just a phone call away.


WAYS TO STAY IN TOUCH WITH FEMA

Deadline to Apply for Physical Disaster Loans Approaching in Ohio; Permanent Saturday Closure of Business Recovery Center

ATLANTA – The [U.S. Small Business Administration \(SBA\)](#) is reminding businesses, private nonprofit organizations, homeowners and renters in **Ohio** affected by tornadoes that occurred on March 14 to apply for physical damage disaster loans by the **July 1** deadline. Additionally, the Business Recovery Center in Ohio will permanently close **on Saturdays, beginning June 8**. The center will be open Monday through Friday, 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. until **June 28**.

Customer Service Representatives at SBA's Business Recovery Center will assist business owners to complete their disaster loan application, accept documents, and provide updates on an application's status. Walk-ins are accepted, but you can [schedule an in-person appointment at an SBA Disaster Recovery Center in advance](#). The Center will operate as indicated below.

For people who are deaf, hard of hearing, or have a speech disability, please dial 7-1-1 to access telecommunications relay services.

Submit completed loan applications to SBA no later than **July 1, 2024**. The deadline to submit economic injury applications is **Feb. 3, 2025**.
