<u>GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:</u> Contractor shall be responsible for obtaining any necessary permits for any and all work as is required by local and national and local code or jurisdiction requirements. Contractor shall also be responsible for any necessary drawings that may be required to obtain permits. Contractor shall be responsible for any required submittal to local authorities. Contractor shall be responsible for maintaining copies of any required permits at the job - site, and to supply Consultant copies of as requested. Contractor shall be responsible for supplying any bonds, insurance cert's, sub - contractor licenses, EPA licenses, specialty licenses to building departments and consultant. All documents shall be delivered in a timely fashion. Contractor shall apply for permits as soon as possible.	\$
<u>ELECTRICAL SYSTEM:</u> Contractor shall upgrade the electrical system, which shall include but not be limited to; new wiring, New grounded electrical outlets, New GFCI outlets, New switches, New complete electrical panel with breakers, Secondary disconnect-60AMP, Photo electric Heat and smoke detectors hard wired Carbon Monoxide & Smoke combination detector by hard wired Junctions boxes for fixtures, Exterior water proof outlet. All wiring sizes, electrical panels, circuit designs, shall be specified by a licensed electrical contractor or engineer and approved by the local building department. Contractor responsible for any damage done to walls and ceilings. Contractor will be using all of the existing lighting fixtures.	\$
