ELECTRICAL- SMOKE/CARBON:	\$
Contractor shall install smoke and carbon alarms. Contractor shall furnish and install photo electric heat and	
smoke detectors (hard wired) in new areas or none exists in the home, and if extensive electrical work is to be	
completed. New smoke/carbon alarms shall be properly secured to the ceiling where installed. Units shall be	
tested for proper operation. Contractor responsible for any damage to walls throughout interior installations.	
ELECTRICAL-BASEMENT AND HALLWAY	\$
Electrical Repairs: Contractor shall repair electrical system, which shall include:	
Replacing any missing/defective switch/outlets, securing any loose wires in proper enclosed j-box, covering	
any open j-box, replacing damaged lighting in front and rear hallway, repairing any defective wiring in the

Work shall be in compliance with National and local code and jurisdictional requirements. All work is to be

spouts will be anchored to walls in at least 3 places with tail pieces diverting water from base of building not	
less than 3 feet. Gutters shall have the right amount of fall towards downspouts for proper drainage, slope will	
be 1/4 inch for every 25 ft of gutter.
