



## **Visiting Assistant Professor of Sports Management**

Union Commonwealth University seeks applicants for a 12-month full-time faculty position at the rank of Visiting Assistant Professor of Sports Management, with appointment beginning in the Fall 2026 semester. Candidates must possess a minimum of a master's degree in Sports Administration or closely-related field. This position has a fixed term of one year and may be renewable up to two additional years at the discretion of the University.

The individual hired for this position will be the primary faculty member supporting the University's new undergraduate major in Sports Management, and will have responsibility for coordinating the program, including continued development of the curriculum already partially drafted. This position will also support the University's Exercise Science, Health & Wellness, and Physical Education majors as appropriate based on credentials.

We seek a student-centered teacher who is excited about dynamic pedagogy. The position will have teaching responsibility for a wide variety of undergraduate courses in sports management courses such as introduction to sport management, marketing, finance/economics, law/ethics, governance/policy, event and facility management, communications/media, sales/revenue, analytics (foundations), and internship/capstone supervision. We are especially interested in qualified candidates who are excited to teach general education courses and interdisciplinary students and who are committed to recruiting new majors from general education courses. Comfortable familiarity with educational technologies is essential, and a student-centered pedagogical approach is a must.

Union faculty are also responsible for student advising, service to the institution, active participation in the life of the campus, and ongoing professional development. This is a location-bound position, and the person hired for the position must reside within reasonable commuting distance to campus and be physically present on campus at least four days per week during the traditional academic year.

Screening of applicants will begin immediately and continue until the position is filled.
