1. A Breath of Fresh Air,

Hike the Van Tassel Lake Trail. Located at 859 Culloden Rd,
A 6-minute drive from the resort, this trail takes approximately one hour to hike
and is rated as moderate.

Hike the Acacia Valley Trails. Located at 155 Mill Rd.
A 15-minute drive from the resort.
These trails connect to others on Crown land.

Hike Gulliver's Cove Trail located at 703 Gulliver's Cove Rd.
An 18-minute drive from the resort...and stunning views.

Annapolis Basin. The current Point Prim Lighthouse is the fourth in a line of lighthouses built
around 1804. You may find yourselves enjoying the sounds of the bagpipes, some of our local's
often play at sunset, make sure to stop and check out the souvenir shop.

13. Balancing Rock

20 tonnes or more of volcanic rock balanced precariously on a ledge above the waves of St. Mary's Bay.

The 1.7 km Balancing Rock Trail leads visitors from the parking lot, just off Highway 217 outside Tiverton, through woods and bog to the southern shore of Long Island.

At the end of the trail, a series of 253 wooden steps provide access to a cliffside viewing platform overlooking the 20-foot-high finger of basalt.
