17 Great Activities in Digby & Area: Winter 2023

Digby

- 1. A Breath of Fresh Air!
- Hike (or snowshoe) the Van Tassel Lake Trail.

A 6-minute drive from The Pines, this trail takes approximately one hour to hike and is rated as moderate (GPS Coordinates 44.65323918319316, -65.8014631342321).

• Cross country ski or hike the Acacia Valley Trails.

These trails connect to others on crown land via the Hardwood Ridge Trail.

4. Visit **Point Prim Lighthouse** at 1417 Lighthouse Rd.

The current Point Prim Lighthouse is the fourth in a line of lighthouses built at Point Prim since 1804. It is located at the mouth of the Digby Gut, which connects the Bay of Fundy with the Annapolis Basin. It is located approximately 8.5 km outside Digby. (GPS Coordinates 44.691115552264066, -65.78574125749763).
