Friday, May 8 – Fieldtrip – ABQ Biopark

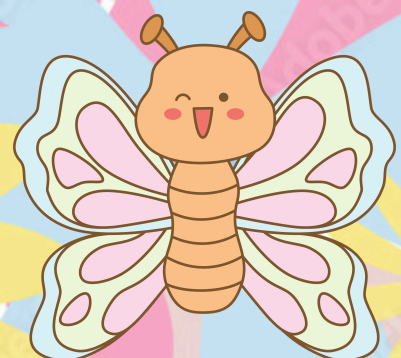
Tuesday, May 12 – Principal's Meeting (Mrs. Medina off campus the entire day)

## Ms. Vanessa's 3s

We have about four more weeks to go! April has been such an amazing and productive month for us. During this time, students have been learning all about spring what we see, hear, and experience during the season. We've talked about changes in the weather, new plant growth, and the different animals we might notice. Students have especially enjoyed observing the life cycle of a butterfly and learning about each stage it goes through, from caterpillar to chrysalis to butterfly. In math, we are continuing to practice counting from 1-20 in English and 1-10 in Spanish. Students are also working on counting backward from 20, which has been a fun challenge. We are building confidence with number recognition and encouraging students to use counting in everyday classroom activities. In literacy, students have been working hard on letter recognition.

We have introduced all the letters, and now we are revisiting them to deepen understanding. We are focusing on identifying each letter, recognizing their shapes, and discussing how many sides they have. Students are also practicing connecting letters to their sounds, which is helping build a strong foundation for early reading skills. In religion, our focus has been on showing love for Jesus by being kind, caring, and helpful to others. We have been talking about making good choices, using kind words, and showing respect to our classmates and teachers. Students are learning that small acts of kindness can make a big difference in our classroom community.
