WHEREAS, pursuant to the Pennsylvania Second Class Township Code, the Board of Supervisors of Brady's Bend Township are responsible for the employment of certain individuals to assist in general maintenance and the maintenance of certain Township roadways for the safe travel of residents and travelers, and:

WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of the Board of Supervisors of Brady's Bend Township to set work rules and conditions for employees of the Township, and:

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Brady's Bend Township have in the past and may continue to employ Supervisors as road crew and general maintenance employees, and:

WHEREAS, after careful consideration and review, the Board of Supervisors of Brady's Bend Township have determined that it is in the best interests of the Township to establish and set the number of hours Supervisors of the Township working as general maintenance and road crew employees may work,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

1. Effective upon passage of this resolution, all Supervisors working as general maintenance or road crew employees shall be required to keep a record of all time worked. Such record shall be maintained by the use of the Township provided time clock.
2. The hours of any Supervisor employed by Township as a general maintenance employee or road crew employee shall not exceed twenty-four (24) hours per week.
3. The said time limit of twenty-four (24) hours per week may be waived by the Board of Supervisors in the event of a weather or other emergency.
4. The Brady's Bend Township Board of Supervisors may, from time to time and at their discretion, change the operational policies and time available to Supervisors employed by the Township.

RESOLUTION NO. 0525

WHEREAS, the Township of Brady's Bend is a municipality formed and operating under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and;

WHEREAS, it is the duty and obligation of the Supervisors of the Township of Brady's Bend to ensure the health and safety of the residents of the Township, and;

WHEREAS, the Supervisors of the Township of Brady's Bend are authorized under the Pennsylvania Township Code to encumber and expend the general and other funds of the Township, and;

WHEREAS, the Brady's Bend Sewer Authority is an independent agency created by the Supervisors of the Township of Brady's Bend to provide sanitary sewer services to the residents of the Township, and;

WHEREAS, the provision of such services are essential to the health, well-being and safety of the residents of the Township, and;

WHEREAS, the Brady's Bend Sewer Authority has applied for a grant from SWSG for the purpose of system upgrades to the sanitary sewer system serving the residents of the Township, and;

WHEREAS, the grant application requires that certain funds be guaranteed in order to secure the grant, and;

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that the Brady's Bend Sewer Authority will have the matching funds available to secure the grant, and;

WHEREAS, the Supervisors of the Township of Brady's Bend, under the general authority granted to them under the Pennsylvania Township Code to encumber and expend funds believes that it is in the best interests of the Township and its residents that the sanitary sewer project moves forward,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, as follows:

1. The Supervisors of the Township of Brady's Bend will commit the sum of \$56,659.68 as a matching guarantee to secure the grant funding for the Brady's Bend Sewer Authority project.
2. The said funds shall only be expended upon proof provided by Brady's Bend Sewer Authority that it is unable to provide the matching funds from the Authorities' reserves.
3. The said monies, if necessary, shall be provided from the Township's general fund or other unencumbered funds.
4. This resolution shall become effective upon enactment.



SECTION 1. That a tax be and the same is hereby levied on all property within the said Township, subject to taxation for Township purposes beginning January 1, 2026, as follows:


(A) Tax rate for general Township purposes, the sum of 9 MILLS on each dollar of assessed valuation.


