### **PLEDGE TO THE FLAG**

MINUTES: March 2026 meeting minutes were reviewed and approved. Motion by Phil, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Bob, approved by all, motion carried. Special Working Meeting March 2026 minutes were reviewed and approved. Motion by Phil, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Bob, approved by all, motion carried.

TREASURER REPORT: was read and approved. Motion by Bob, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Phil, approved by all, motion carried.

HOLIDAY PAY RESOLUTION: was tabled until May 4<sup>th</sup> meeting since it wasn't added to the Agenda beforehand. Will be voted on and signed May 4<sup>th</sup>.

Also set to be in Butler Eagle on April 13 and April 16. \* We made our final PIB loan payment. \$130,000 loan for red truck and Kaylor Frogtown repaving project. Paid in full. \*Tammy will work on a draft of a driveway permit application this month \*We received a check from the insurance company for the repair of corner post on overhang. \*Frank gave an update on the status of various grant applications – mostly in a holding/waiting pattern. \*The wrong phone number for Sharon Lucas was printed on the tax bills. We have her correct # listed on the website.

CITIZEN CONCERNS: \* Joe Curran asked for an update on his proposal from last month – no call back from Legion contact. Joe suggested some repairs and building of a “curb” on St Mary’s Lane. Also talked about need for a state police speed trap in front of the township building. \* Gordon Cogley requested that we
