

BRADY'S BEND TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS MEETING

July 6, 2026

Meeting began at 6:06pm

Supervisors present, Frank Bratkovich and Phil Anderson. Bob Kabay was absent.

PLEDGE TO THE FLAG

MINUTES: June 2026 regular and working meeting minutes were reviewed and approved. Motion by Phil, 2nd by Frank, approved by all, motion carried.

TREASURER REPORT: was read and approved. Motion by Phil, 2nd by Frank, approved by all, motion carried.

NEW CITIZEN CONCERNS: Joe Curran showed photos of water flowing away from the drains on St. Mary Cemetery Rd at Foust and requested that it be re-sloped. Also requested that the ditch be repaired at the top near the cemetery to redirect water off the road.

OLD BUSINESS: *Grant updates: multimunicipal 4 roads is happening. Roseville on the 6th, Rottman and St. Mary's on the 7th, with youngblood coming soon to tar and chip. Side drain work is continuing on Upper Seybertown in preparation for grant work to happen very soon. Kaylor pet phase 2 will be bid in Feb/March 2027. Main hill grant work is completed and paperwork submitted to request \$25,000 balance that should be received in July. *Citizen Concerns Updates (Hipple – Roseville cold patch done, Curran – fireworks prep completed and legion parking lot work is requested to be done in the fall, Smith – called PSP barracks and learned that they do not enforce township ATV traffic concerns and still plan to place signs we have on hand on Keener Rd.) *Summer work updates (cold patch Roseville and Kaylor Pet, mowing continues with 9 roads done) *Training (secretary in Cranberry completed; D/G in Clarion on July 8-9)

NEW BUSINESS: * COUNTY AID APPLICATION RESOLUTION: was read, signed and approved. Motion by Phil, 2nd by Frank, approved by all, motion carried.

*D/G applications are due Aug 28 and we will apply for retention pond-St. Mary's Cem Rd. Need off right of way from Snyders. *ACCF St. Stephen's \$15,000 grant application was turned in requesting upgrades to water and heat.

ROAD REPORT. *See old business also. *All road evaluations have been completed. Most of the township roads are in fair to poor condition. The data will be assembled in a more readable format and presented at a future meeting. *There are hundreds of culverts on township roads. We have mapped 9 roads and will continue. The larger ones may be marked. Joe Curran offered to lend us a pilot stake to help with marker placement.

MONTHLY BILLS: motion by Phil, 2nd by Frank, motion carried to pay monthly bills.
