June 1, 2026

Meeting began at 6:00pm

Supervisors present, Frank Bratkovich, Bob Kabay and Phil Anderson.

PLEDGE TO THE FLAG

MINUTES: May 2026 meeting minutes as well as special meeting May 12 for bid acceptance, working meeting May 20 to review all proposed road work and grants related to such were reviewed and approved. Motion by Bob, 2nd by Phil, approved by all, motion carried.

TREASURER REPORT: was read and approved. Motion by Bob, 2nd by Phil, approved by all, motion carried.

CITIZEN CONCERNS: *Dylan Hipple asked for update on any plans to address the condition of Roseville Rd. Shared plans related to County multimunicipal grant to begin very soon. *Joe Curran would like the gravel in the Legion parking lot touched up; he would like to fill some potholes and get posts at Nelson's to mark culverts in prep for upcoming fireworks; he reminded township that he needs extra gravel he paid for to be dropped for fireworks; there are potholes on Foust Rd that need filled; finally he asked for update on the St Mary's work that is part of the county multi-municipal grant. *Carl Smith expressed concern about 4 wheelers on Keener Road. It was agreed that we would put up a "no 4 wheeler sign" that we already have on hand. It was also agreed that we would contact the state police barracks to ask if there's anything the township has authority to do. It was suggested that Carl also contact the game commission to see if they'll patrol the area.

ROAD REPORT. *We reviewed a quote for \$13,199 from Russell Standard to crack seal Kaylor Frogtown Road. Jace Hiles is willing to loan us a tar buggy and one worker to do the job. We would just need to buy the sealing material for in the tar buggy. We have sufficient summer help/workers to be able to flag and everything needed. *Update on grants – Waiting on Armstrong Cty planning commission to finalize approval to start the grinding, tar & chip for 4 roads; hope to get the Kaylor Petrolia Rd Phase 2 bids out within a week or two; Dirt & Gravel

grant work began today on Main Hill Road to widen road and add proper drainage
*Upper Seybertown work in prep for the county grant work is completed *
Culvert work was completed on Poncic and Roseville to extend pipe *Hired 2
summer employees (Griffin Booher for Mon-Thurs and Dave McElroy for Tues and
Thurs) *Frank will begin mowing banks * We have had a large number of trees
down *Frank shared that we were awarded \$1,256,343 from TASA for safety
concerns allowing us to add bike lanes on Seybertown Rd but it will likely be 2-3
years before work begins. The township will be responsible to add the 9mm
topcoat at our own expense.

SECRETARY REQUEST: Approval was given for Secretary to attend a two day
training in Cranberry presented by PSATS. June 23-24 for \$195. Motion by Phil, 2nd
by Bob, approved by all, motion carried. *Sheila Markel was given a round of
applause for her years of service in numerous roles over the past decades. She
was instrumental in acquiring grants funding of over \$2.5 million dollars as
township secretary.

MONTHLY BILLS: motion by Bob, 2nd by Phil, motion carried to pay monthly bills.
