



In-Banner Video Ad Booking Instructions (using YouTube player to host video ad file)

Create the video asset:


- 1. Log into your Youtube.com account
- 2. Click on the upload video button in the top right hand corner and then click on the Upload video link



- 3. Select the mp4 video you want to use for the advertiser's campaign
- 4. Once you've done that it brings you to the main page where you give you video a name and processes the video for you
- 5. For safety purposes click on No, it's not made for kids
- 6. Click next



- 7. On the video elements tab, you do not need to do anything so just click next
- 8. On the Checks tab Google will let you know if there are any copyright issues (music, images, etc. that may be copyright protected). If you see a green checkmark you are good so click next
- 9. On the visibility page you need to click "Unlisted" that way it doesn't get published to your channel but anyone looking at the ad on your site will be able to see it.



10. Copy the video link under the preview image and click save – keep that URL for use when booking the ad into Google Ad Manager.

Create the line item and upload creative in Google Ad Manager:


- 11. Set up your order and line item in GAM
 - a. Ad size is 300x250, 300x600 or 970x250
 - b. Choose your inventory targeting, i.e. domainname.com
 - c. Save the line item

12. Add the creative

- a. Use the Flex In-Banner Video Ad (Alpha) creative template
- b. Fill out the click tag (advertiser's clickthru URL)
- c. Ad Size 300x250 (Full Video), 300x600 (Full Video), 970x250 (Full Video)
 - i. You can choose inset video for each of those sizes, it adds a 5 pixel border around the video
- d. Add the image files these are optional
 - i. If you choose to not add a background image, the video will "float" in the 300x250, 300x600 or 970x250 ad space and the ad will not click through to the advertiser's website and would not provide any metrics other than impressions delivered
 - ii. If you choose to use a background image they need to be made as follows:
 - 1. 300x250 build the image as 300x250 the bottom 300x80 pixels is where the advertiser's message goes the video will overlay the top portion of that image.
 - 2. 300x600 build the image as 300x600 the bottom 300x430 is where the advertiser message goes the video will overlay the top portion of the image
 - 3. 970x250 build the image as 970x250 the right portion of the image 525x250 is where the advertiser message goes the video will overlay the left side of the image
- e. Place your YouTube Embed URL the link only, into the VideoURL slot
 - i. You can get this specific link by clicking the share button in YouTube > embed> then copying the URL out of the embed code.
 - 1. This is the entire embed code example, you DO NOT want this in GAM
