SEASONAL REMINDER

As temperatures cool across South Dakota, please make sure your child is prepared for outdoor play and travel to and from school. We go outside whenever the weather allows, so proper clothing helps keep everyone safe and comfortable.

Outdoor Play Guidelines:

- Above 50°F: Short sleeves
- 40–50°F: Long sleeves Below
- 40°F: Coat, hat, and gloves. Snow on the ground: Coat, boots, hat, and gloves

If the temperature (including windchill) drops below 40°F, outdoor time may be shortened or moved indoors. If your family needs help with fall clothing, please let us know — we're happy to connect you with local resources.

No matter the forecast, the Club is here to support your family:

- On snow days, we're open 7:30 AM 6:00 PM
- If school dismisses early due to weather, the Club will open after school and remain open until 6:00 PM (unless otherwise noted).
