TRANSPORTATION

Elementary & Camelot Transportation:

The Club partners with the Brookings School District to ensure all members are safely transported from schools to the Club each day.

To use this service, families must:

- Have an active Club membership in good standing
- Sign up for busing in the Caregiver Portal (MCH) — Elementary members only
- Notify both the school and your child's teacher that they'll be riding the bus to the Club

Please note: Only current Club members are eligible for transportation.

Mickelson Middle School Transportation:
Middle schoolers will walk to the Teen Center
after dismissal. Please remind your teens of
the importance of using crosswalks when
crossing the street. We strongly encourage
members to use the newly built crosswalk
at the corner of Southland Lane and 12th


