ENROLLMENT & PAYMENT

- Your child's fall starts with enrollment — and getting it done early means their spot is secured and they're ready to go from day one. Complete enrollment through the Caregiver Portal (MyClubHub) before fall begins.
 - If your TEEN already has a 2026 membership, you're all set; it's valid through December, and no additional registration is needed for fall programs.
- Non-Club members need to pay \$1, which is due at check-in.
- Members not enrolled by the first day will be charged \$1 per day until enrollment is complete.
- Your MyClubHub account must show a zero balance or active payment plan to join fee-based activities.

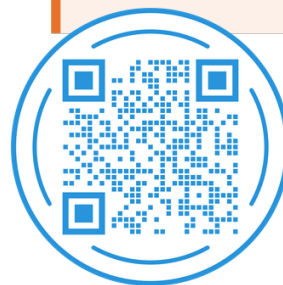

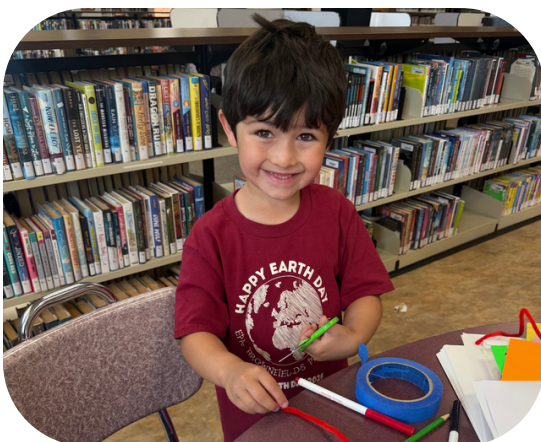

Important Reminders

- Reality Store extends the impact of Money Matters: Make It Count SM, which builds the decision-making and behavioral skills of teens in core financial concepts such as goal-setting, budgeting, spending wisely, saving and investing. Teens envision the lifestyle they would like to have when they are in their late 20s and receive one month's salary to spend on basic living expenses for their family. Juggling income and expenses, teens will experience financial opportunities as well as setbacks, and develop positive behaviors they can apply in their own lives. The game helps teens discover if their occupation provides the financial resources needed to live the lifestyle they want.
