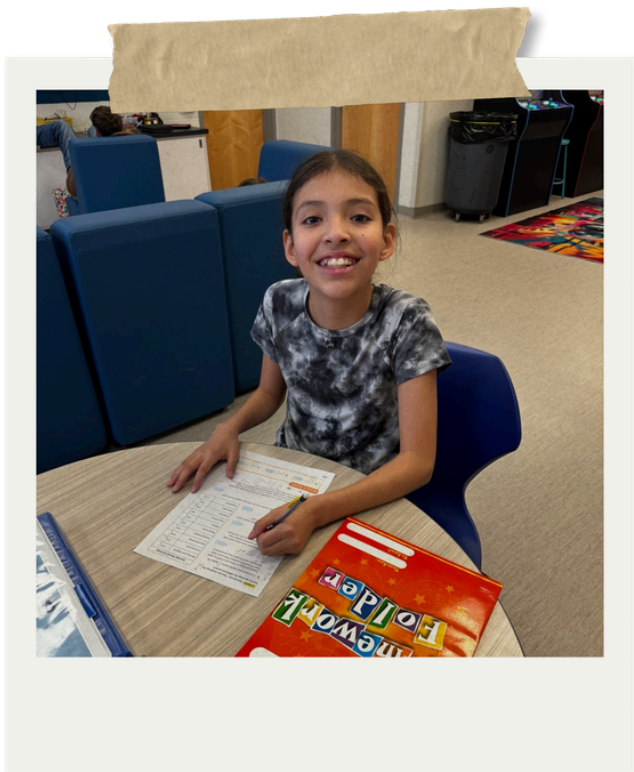

# WHO WE SERVE

## MOODY COUNTY TRADITIONAL SITE:

The Moody County Club serves youth in Junior Kindergarten through 5th grade, offering a safe, positive, and engaging environment after school and throughout the summer. Members take part in a wide range of programs designed to support academic success, provide enriching experiences, strengthen social-emotional skills, promote good character and leadership, and encourage healthy lifestyles and recreation—all led by caring, trained staff who are committed to helping every child build confidence and thrive in school and in life.

To be eligible for Elementary Club programming this summer, youth must be entering Junior Kindergarten/Kindergarten during the 2026–2027 school year. Current 4th grade members will transition to the Teen Center at the start of summer programming.



## MOODY COUNTY TEEN ROOM:

The Teen Center serves youth in 5th through 12th grade, providing a safe and welcoming space where teens can learn, grow, and connect. Programs are designed to support academic success, build leadership skills, prepare members for the workforce, and promote healthy lifestyles. Through a mix of structured activities and teen-led opportunities, members develop confidence, responsibility, strong character, and the skills they need to succeed beyond high school.



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## MEMBERSHIP OPTIONS FOR SUMMER 2026:

To keep Club access affordable and flexible for families, the Boys & Girls Club of the Northern Plains offers seasonal memberships levels at all traditional Club sites. Every member receives the same high-quality programs, supportive staff, and safe environment—families simply choose the rate that works best for them and their budget.

### Enrollment Information

- Enrollment is now open on the Caregiver Portal (MyClubHub)
- **Summer enrollment deadline:** May, 25 2026
- Enrollment will remain open after May 25 as space and scholarship funding allow.

**Family Cap:** No family pays membership fees for more than three (3) Club members. Membership for the 4th, 5th, and any additional youth is covered at no cost. This applies to all members enrolled in any of our Traditional Club programs, Junior Kindergarten through 12th grade.

**Teen Program (5th–12th Grade):** Membership remains \$100 per year and is not affected by this change. If your Teen is already enrolled in the Teen Center for 2026 no further registration is needed.

**Financial Support:** Scholarships ranging from 20%–100% off and payment plans are available to ensure every child who wants to attend the Club can do so.

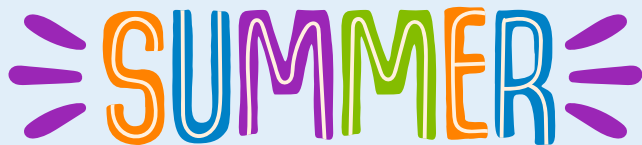

## Orientation & Access

- **Orientation is required: June 1 | 11:00 AM**
  - Sign up is not required. All Club members will go with the Club to the pool for the swim test.
  - Swim test includes a standard assessment, conducted by pool lifeguards. All members must pass this basic swim test to participate in pool outings
- Must have an active pool pass or money for the pool
- Drop-off at the Club by 12:15 PM
- Club will walk to and from the pool
- All youth must return to the Club before pickup
- Snack will be served upon return to the Club
- **Pool outings will begin the week of June 1**

On Site at the Club

- Members will enjoy water activities at the Club, including water balloons, slim & slide, and more!

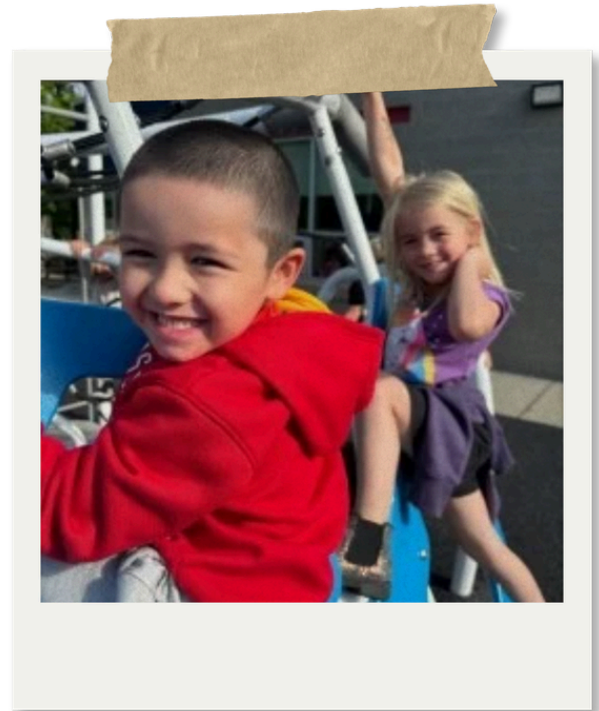
## Community Event:

## Important Reminders

- Registration for all activities and field trips open two weeks prior to the event through the Caregiver Portal (MyClubHub).
- All youth must have an active Club membership to register for and attend any fee-based programs, field trips, or pool outings.
- Youth participating in pool outings are required to attend a pool orientation and successfully complete the swim test.
- Parents/guardians must come inside to pick up their members daily. Teens may check themselves out of the Teen Center only with approved permissions. Permissions can be updated at any time in the Caregiver Portal (MyClubHub).
- Youth are not permitted to bring items from home unless specifically approved (such as pool gear, a packed snack or lunch, or items required for a field trip).
- We are a peanut-free facility.
- Cell phone use is an earned privilege:
  - 3rd & 4th grade members may use personal devices only during designated phone/technology times.
  - Teens are allowed to have cell phones but must follow all Club cell phone policies.



## **FLANDREAU SUMMER RECREATION**

**The Flandreau Summer Recreation Program is here again this summer. This year the program is operated by the Boys & Girls Club of Moody County. Everything you loved is still here — we are simply the organization running it.**

### **How to Register**

All registration is done through MyClubHub, our online caregiver portal. There are two types of memberships — choose the one that works best for your family.

The MyClubHub Caregiver Portal is your one-stop online account for managing your child's enrollment at Boys & Girls Club of Moody County. Through MyClubHub, you can register for memberships and summer rec camps, complete required waivers, and stay up to date on important information — all in one place. ### **Option 1: Moody County Summer Rec Membership — Summer Rec Camps Only**

Choose this option if your child will be attending summer rec camps only. In MyClubHub, select the — Moody County Summer Rec Membership. Once enrolled, register for the individual camps your child wants to attend. For this option, families are only paying the summer rec camp fee.

·On camp days: free Club access before and after camp, transportation, breakfast, lunch, and two snacks — all included at no additional cost

·On non-camp days: Club access is not included in this membership. A \$2 daily drop-in fee applies if your child would like to attend

### **Option 2: Moody County Semester Membership — Full Club Access + Summer Rec Camps (Strongly Encouraged)**

Choose this option if your child will be attending the Club throughout the summer in addition to summer rec camps. In MyClubHub, select the — Moody County Semester Membership and complete enrollment. Once your membership is active, you can sign up for summer rec camps under Programs in your MCH portal — you will not be charged for any camps you register for.

·Summer rec camps are included in this membership

·Full Club access all summer — on camp days and non-camp days

·Transportation, breakfast, lunch, and two snacks on camp days

·Field trips, daily activities, and enrichment programs all summer (field trips and activities may be fee-based)
