NEW MEMBERSHIP OPTIONS FOR 2026

To keep Club access affordable and flexible for families, Boys & Girls Club of the Northern Plains will transition to seasonal memberships beginning this spring. Every member will continue to enjoy the same high-quality programs, caring staff, and safe environment—families simply select the rate that fits their budget.

Seasonal Membership Levels

Spring (Jan.-May): \$50 • \$100 • \$150

Summer (May-Aug.): \$150 • \$200 • \$250

Fall (Aug.-Dec.): \$50 • \$100 • \$150

Enrollment Information

- Enrollment opens January 5, 2026, on the Caregiver Portal (MyClubHub)
- Spring enrollment deadline: February 2, 2026
- Enrollment will remain open after February 2 as space and scholarship funding allow.

Family Cap: No family pays membership fees for more than three (3) Club members. Membership for the 4th, 5th, and any additional youth is covered at no cost. This applies to all members enrolled in any of our Traditional Club programs, Junior Kindergarten through 12th grade.

Teen Program (5th-12th Grade): Membership remains \$100 per year and is not affected by this change.

Financial Support: Scholarships ranging from 20%–100% off and payment plans are available to ensure every child who wants to attend the Club can do so.

JOIN US for **FREE** Impact Programs that inspire curiosity, encourage healthy habits, build leadership skills, and prepare members for great futures, all in a safe and supportive Club environment.

JK - 4th Grade

Cinema Club

Mondays | 4:00–5:00 PM | 3rd–4th Grade

Members will watch films that highlight themes such as courage, integrity, and inclusion. After each movie, youth will participate in an activity that helps them apply the lesson to real-life situations.

Go2Science

Wednesdays | 4:00–4:30 PM | JK–2nd Grade

Members will “travel the world” through virtual field trips that explore different countries, ecosystems, and wildlife. Each session includes hands-on activities and videos designed to build curiosity and a deeper understanding of our planet.

Triple Play

Fridays | 4:30–5:00 PM | 2nd–4th Grade

Triple Play helps youth develop the skills, attitudes, and healthy habits they need for overall well-being through activities that support the mind, body, and soul.

HOMEWORK HELP

Academic success starts with support, and we're here to help.

Teens (5 - 12th Grade)

Power Hour / Homework Help

Monday–Friday

Teens receive academic support each afternoon through guided homework help, quiet workspaces, and staff assistance to build strong study habits and confidence.

Youth Arts

Mondays | 4:00–5:30 PM

Teens will explore creativity through all four pillars of the arts: visual, performing, digital, and applied. Each session introduces new techniques and projects that help teens express themselves and discover new interests.

All Stars

Wednesdays | 4:00–5:00 PM

Teens can get in the game with ALL STARS, the Club’s organized sports program featuring flag football, volleyball, basketball, and soccer. Activities focus on teamwork, friendly competition, skill-building, and staying active with friends.

Digital Literacy

Fridays | 4:00–4:30 PM

Teens will build foundational technology skills, including online safety, typing, web navigation, digital collaboration, and responsible gaming. This program helps prepare members for success in school and future careers.

Members will participate in an MLB-themed competition featuring skill challenges and friendly games.


COMMUNITY EVENT

Reminder → TOYS & ITEMS FROM HOME

To keep the Club safe, organized, and focused on learning and fun, we ask that all toys and personal items from home stay at home or in your child's backpack during program hours. Please note that the Club is not responsible for any items from home that may be lost, stolen, or broken. Thank you for helping us create a positive environment for all members!

Reminder → BEHAVIOR POLICY

- At Boys & Girls Club, we want all members to feel safe, respected, and supported. To help with this, we use a point system to address behavior concerns in a fair and consistent way:
- **Consequence Form (1 point):** For smaller behavior issues.
- **Incident Report (2 points):** For more serious concerns (such as hurting others, threats, theft, or possession of substances).
- **Daily Rule:** 3 points in one day = member must be picked up or stay home the next day.
- **Weekly Rule:** 5 points in one week = member must be picked up and take at least one day off.
- Additional steps may include short suspensions for more serious actions (such as harming staff, damaging property, or repeated issues). Points reset weekly, and our team reviews each situation carefully.
- This system helps members learn accountability while giving them the chance to grow and improve. Thank you for partnering with us to ensure a safe and positive Club experience for all kids!

Reminder → Cell Phones & Social Media

Use of Facebook, Snapchat, TikTok, and all camera or video features on personal devices is not allowed while at the Club. This protects the privacy and safety of every member.



Reminder → Teen Center Reminders

To ensure the Teen Center remains a safe, fun, and welcoming space for everyone:

- **No Camera Use**
- Teens may not use the camera or video functions on their mobile devices while at the Teen Center. This helps us maintain a secure environment and protect the privacy of all members.
