We're kicking off a brand new year of fun, learning, and community at the Boys & Girls Club of Vermillion — and we've got exciting news to share!

Thanks to generous grant support, we're launching a NEW Traditional Site this fall for enrolled members in 3rd–12th grade — and it's **FREE** with your Club membership through June 2026, thanks to funding from the 21st Century Community Learning Centers Grant!

What's a Traditional Club?

Our Traditional Club is an unlicensed after-school program that gives kids and teens more freedom and choice in their time. Members can lead, learn, and grow with caring mentors, hands-on activities, and a safe space to explore their interests.

Who Can Join?

• Elementary Site: 3rd-5th grade

• Teen Club: 6th-12th grade

Join Our Morning Program!

We're excited to offer Morning Program this school year, giving kids a safe, welcoming place to start their day before the bell rings.

Open to all enrolled JK–5th grade members, this program helps families get a strong start to the day with peace of mind.

Program Details:

Starts: August 20 (first day of school)

Hours: 6:00–8:00 AM

- Transportation: Kids will be transported to their schools in time for breakfast. Drop off required no later than 7:30 AM
- Morning Snack: A light breakfast or snack will be provided. Members will be transported to school in time for breakfast.

Cost: \$100/Semester (August - December)

Academy Program (JK–2nd Grade)

Our Academy Program continues to serve our JK– 2nd –grade members in our licensed, high-quality care spaces — offering structured care, hands-on activities, and support from caring staff every day after school.

Thours: After school until 6:00 PM

- Afterschool: Snack provided for ALL members, every day.

On full days (including no-school days and inclement weather days), all members must bring a nut-free sack lunch. Please note that we do not have access to refrigerators or microwaves, so pack lunches that do not require heating or refrigeration.
