Trip and camp dates/times may change. Stay tuned for updates.

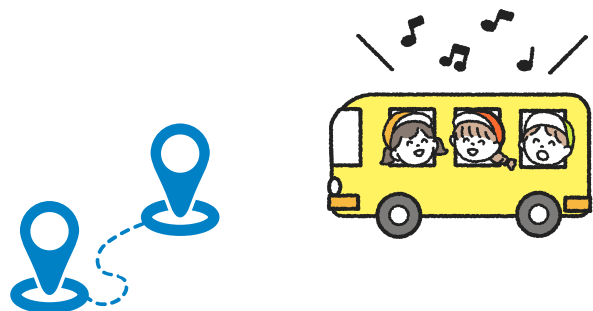
Camps:

Yankton Academy:

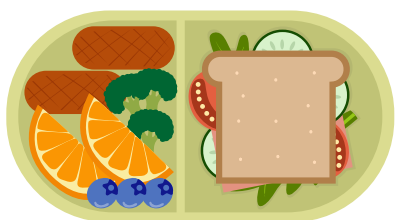
- Staff will transport members by vehicle to the Middle School for meal pick-up.

- Meals are stored at the Club and served during regular mealtimes:
 - **Breakfast:** 9:00 AM
 - **Lunch:** 11:00 AM
- Please arrive by 10:30 AM on pick-up days. Youth arriving after this time will still be transported to pick up meals, as long as it's before 1:00 PM.

On Fridays, members receive take-home meals to cover both Saturday and Sunday.
