

Using Your Dehumidifier : Quick Start Guide

This machine is here to help keep your home dry and comfortable. To make sure it works its best, please follow these simple steps!

How It Works

- Auto-Run: The machine pulls moisture from the air and collects it in a water tray.
- Auto-Stop: When the tray is full, the machine will automatically turn off so it doesn't overflow.
- Restarting: Most machines start back up on their own after you empty them. If it doesn't, just push the "Start" or "Power" button.

Emptying the Water

The machine needs your help to keep running! You must empty the water tray:

- Whenever it is full (the "Full" light will usually blink).
- At least 2 times a day (once in the morning and once at night is best).

Where to empty it:

- Carefully pull the tray out.
- Pour the water into your sink or bathtub.
- Slide the tray back in until it clicks.

Important Tips

- Keep it Clear: Make sure there are at least 12 inches of space around the machine. Don't block the vents with furniture or curtains.
- Keep it Level: Make sure the machine is sitting flat on the floor.
- Close Windows: For the best results, keep nearby windows and doors closed while the machine is running.
