

June 1, 2026

The New Castle City Commission meeting was held on Monday, June 1, 2026 at 6pm. Present was Mayor Phoebe Thompson, Commissioners Tony Kurtz, Cheryl Hay, Sarah Golden and Jennifer Delling. Also present was City Clerk Lynn Adams, City Attorney Josh Clubb and Public Works Director Joey Bramblett.

Mayor Thompson called the meeting to order.

Commissioner Golden made the motion to accept the minutes from all the May meetings as presented. Commissioner Hay seconded the motion. The motion did carry unanimously.

Commissioner Kurtz made the motion to approve all financial activity for May of 2026. Commissioner Delling seconded the motion. It carried unanimously.

Mayor Thompson checked online balances in city held accounts.

64 hours were logged for the City by two deputies for the month of May. There were 16 traffic stops, 7 citations issued, one arrest made, 15 complaints investigated, 13 case opened and 12 other incidents handled.

Commissioner Hay made the motion to have 2nd reading of Ordinance #26-01, FISCAL YEAR 25/26 AMENDED BUDGET ORDINANCE FOR THE CITY OF NEW CASTLE, KY. Commissioner Kurtz seconded the motion which carried unanimously.

Attorney Clubb gave 2nd reading of Ordinance #26-01.

Commissioner Delling made the motion to adopt Ordinance #26-01. Commissioner Golden seconded the motion which did carry unanimously.

Commissioner Hay made the motion to have 2nd reading of Ordinance #26-02, FISCAL YEAR 26/27 BUDGET ORDINANCE FOR THE CITY OF NEW CASTLE, KY. Commissioner Kurtz seconded the motion. It carried unanimously.

Attorney Clubb gave 2nd reading of Ordinance #26-02.

Commissioner Kurtz made the motion to adopt Ordinance #26-02. Commissioner Delling seconded the motion. It carried unanimously.

Deputy contracts were reviewed for the fiscal year 26/27.

Commissioner Delling made the motion to approve the contracts with Deputy Napier and Major Jamiel for the fiscal year 26/27. Commissioner Golden seconded the motion. It carried unanimously.

A donation to the Revolutionary War Monument was discussed.

Commissioner Hay made the motion to donate \$100 towards the purchase of the monument. Commissioner Delling seconded and the motion carried unanimously.

As there was no further business to be addressed tonight, Commissioner Kurtz made the motion to adjourn. Commissioner Golden seconded and the motion carried unanimously. The meeting adjourned at 6:20pm.
