STAMP Overview and Program Cost

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Mission:

The mission of the STAMP Academic/Athletic Program is to assist students in learning the fundamentals and success strategies of reading, arithmetic, problem solving and test taking. Many students are failing the state standardized test, and subsequently dropping out of high school or not meeting the minimum requirements for graduation (Certificate of Attendance vs. High School Diploma) and ultimately becoming unproductive citizens in our community. Because of this, STAMP has created a program to empower students with better math and reading skills as well as the skills needed to pass the FCAT and other standardized test. This program is designed to increase the high school graduation rate and to promote good citizenship among our youth.

Strategy:

To promote academic excellence within athletic programs and other activities that kids love by providing an environment of fun and learning and utilizing State standardized test practice books and practice tests, online tutorials, student worksheets and strategic skills for math, reading and test taking. In an effort to maintain interest and promote a fun and exciting learning environment, teachers and volunteers are required to wear athletic/referee uniforms and award points, penalties, and game related results during all academic sessions.

About the Youth:

Students participating in the STAMP program primarily reside in the City of Riviera Beach. The players' grade levels range from 2nd through 12th grade. The majority of the players are being challenged to pass FCAT and other standardized test in order to be promoted to the next grade level or to earn their high school diploma.

Mark G. Brown Sr., founder of STAMP, has coached and mentored hundreds of student and athletes for over twenty-five years.
