



Muskoka Conservancy Bursary 2026 Guidelines

The Muskoka Conservancy Bursary supports students pursuing post-secondary education in **Natural Sciences** (for example, Biology, Forestry, Environmental Studies) or **related Technologies** (for example, Wildlife, Forestry, Environmental Engineering).

To support youth in achieving academic success in these fields, Muskoka Conservancy offers **one bursary of \$2,000** annually.

Bursary Value & Payment

- Total bursary value: **\$2,000**
- Awarded in **two payments of \$1,000**
 - First payment: upon proof of registration in the approved program
 - Second payment: upon proof of attendance in the second term

The successful applicant must demonstrate that they are enrolled in and are attending the course of study specified in their bursary application in order to receive both payments.

Eligibility

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Be a **permanent resident of Ontario**
- Reside within the geographic boundaries of the **District of Muskoka**
- Be a **current attendee or graduate** of a secondary school located within those boundaries
- Be enrolled in or **entering their first year of post-secondary studies** in:
 - Natural Sciences or related technologies

Requirements

Applicants must submit the following:

1. A **completed online application form**, found at: <https://forms.office.com/r/Yem9XstVh2>
2. **One letter of recommendation** from a teacher, employer, volunteer supervisor, community leader, or similar. (Letters from family members will not be accepted.)
3. A **current résumé**
4. **Proof of acceptance or enrollment** in the stated program (**if available at time of application**)

Deadline

- **Monday June 1, 2026.** Late applications will not be accepted.

Applications must be completed using the **online application form**.
