Miss Williams will check the Reading Records on a Monday morning and if your child has read at least three times, with an adult during the week, they will receive two house points. Reading Records are also a great way to keep regular contact, so please do not hesitate to write a message or note for me. I cannot stress the importance of your child(ren) reading on a daily basis even if it is for 5 minutes. It really makes a difference to your child's learning.

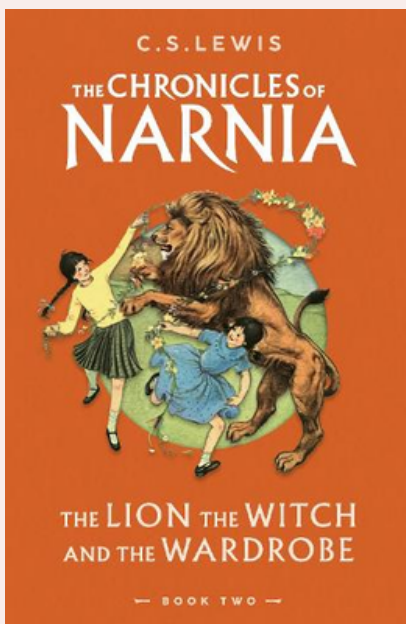
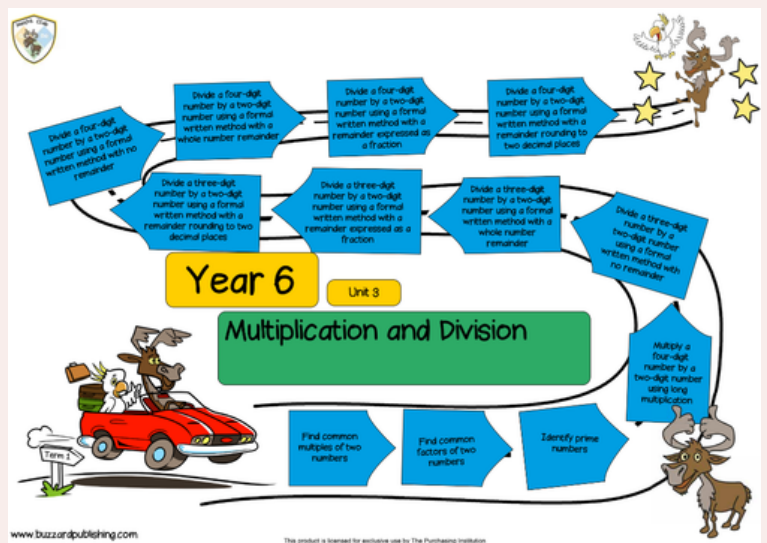
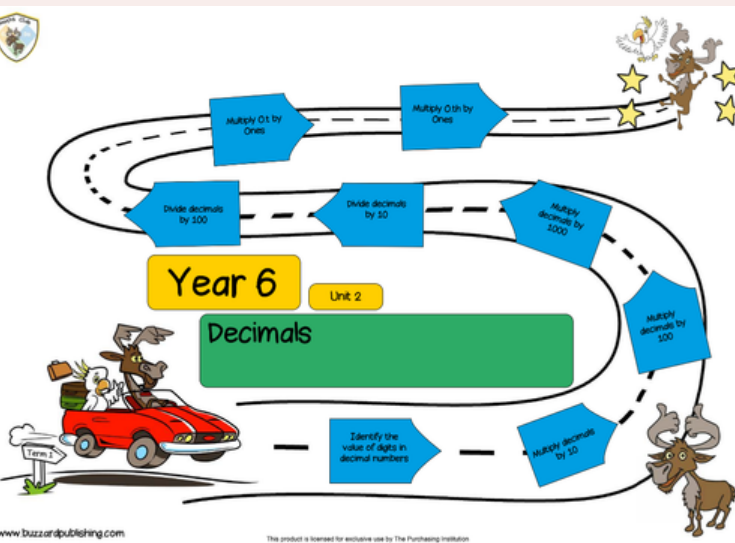
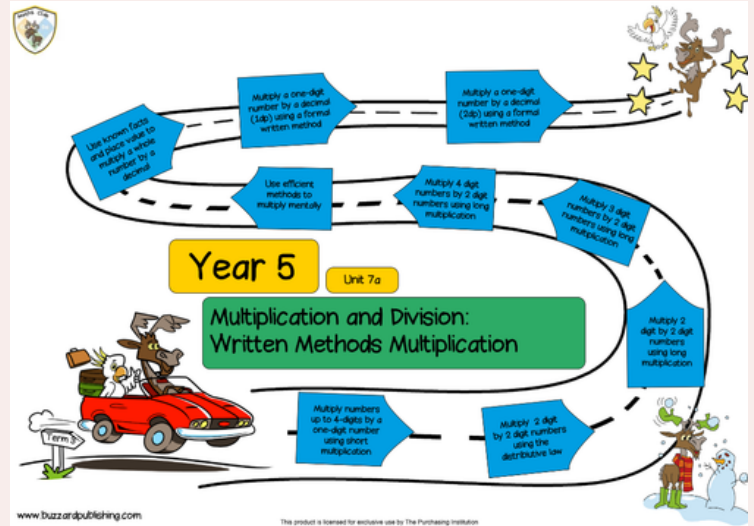
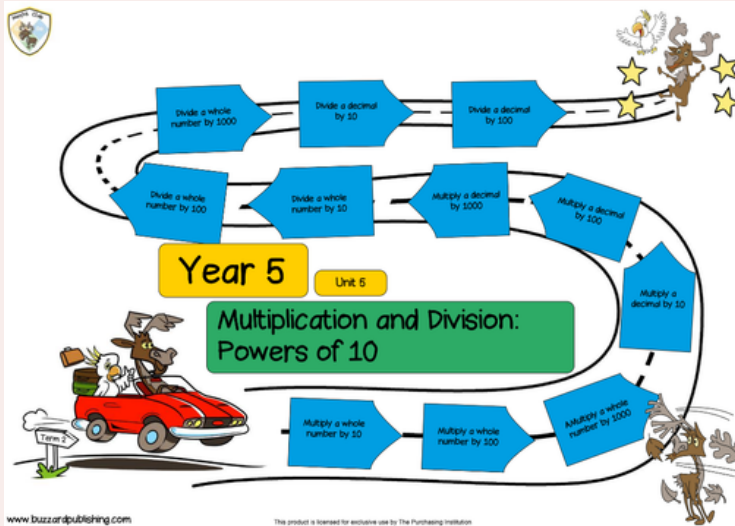


Attendance
