but I will hold you responsible for his death.

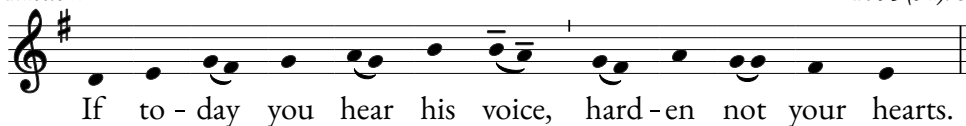

and by the Holy Spirit was incarnate of the Virgin Mary, and became man.

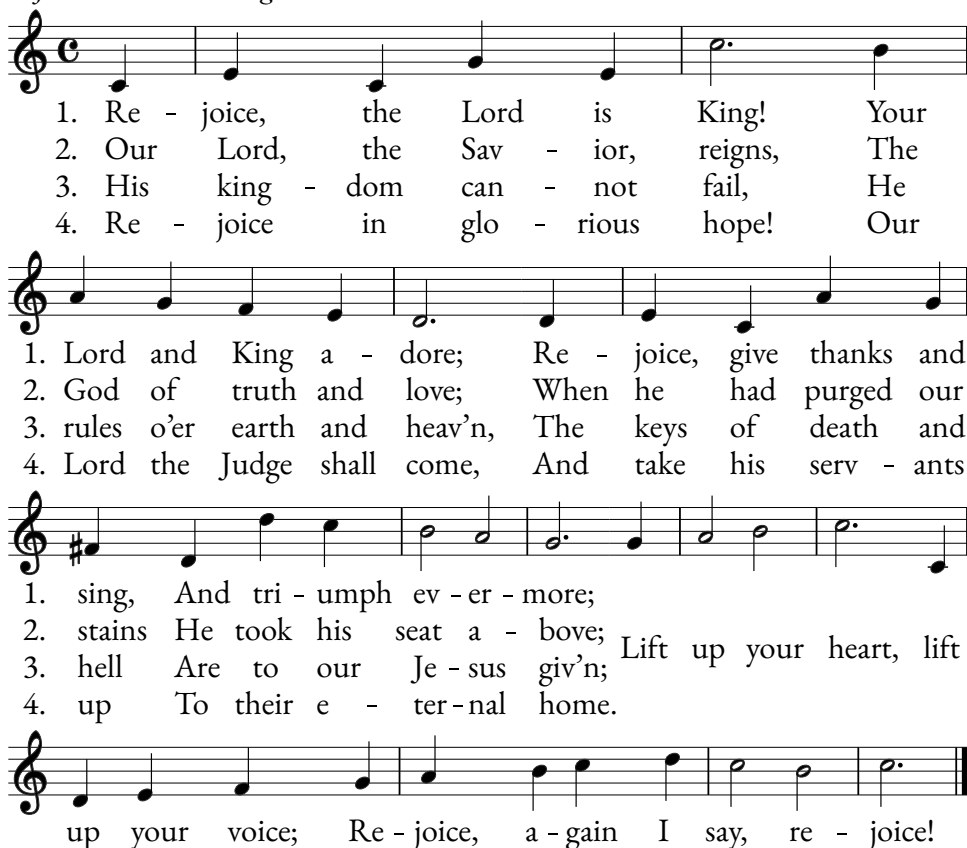
For our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilate,

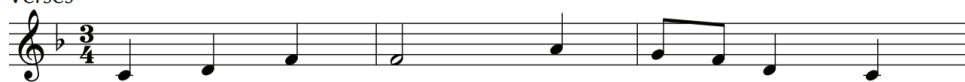

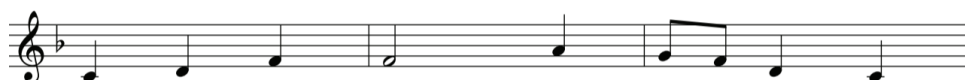

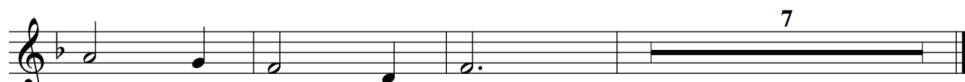
