Do not mix with other chemicals, especially acids, alkalis, bleach or oxidising agents unless supplier confirms compatibility. Keep away from food, drink and incompatible cleaning products as good practice.	Store in a cool, well-ventilated place. Keep container closed when not in use, upright and clearly labelled. Store in designated COSHH/cleaning store with SDS/RAMS available. Prevent leaks entering drains; use containment for 5L containers where practicable.	Keep on approved chemical list only with current SDS/RAMS. Brief staff on correct dilution, PPE and spill controls. Check container condition before issue/use. Remove damaged or unlabelled containers from use immediately.

Floor mopping 1:160 (0.60%). Heavy duty floor cleaning 1:20 (5%). Spray/wipe hard surface cleaning 1:25 (4%). Washroom floor mopping 1:100 (1%). Washroom spray/wipe hard surface cleaning 1:20 (5%).	Ensure good ventilation, especially during spray work. Avoid breathing spray/mist; avoid splashing into eyes. Do not eat, drink or smoke when using. Wash hands after use. Use wet floor signs during mopping/floor cleaning.	Apply by mop, spray/wipe, or approved cleaning method only. For spray use, apply away from faces and avoid overspray. Use on suitable non-porous surfaces; test delicate surfaces where needed. Do not use neat unless specifically authorised by manager/COSHH assessment.	Eye protection for general hard surface cleaning and where splash risk exists. Safety footwear/boots for mopping and floor tasks. Use protective gloves and eye protection as required by SDS. Clean spills promptly using absorbent material; avoid release to the environment.
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FIRST AID MEASURES (4)

Inhalation: move person to fresh air and keep comfortable for breathing. Seek advice if symptoms occur or person feels unwell.	Skin: wash with plenty of water/soap and water. If skin irritation or rash occurs, get medical advice/attention. Wash contaminated clothing before reuse.	Eyes: rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. If irritation persists, get medical advice/attention.	Ingestion: get immediate medical advice/attention. Do not induce vomiting unless told by medical personnel. Show product container/SDS where possible.

Spill residues/absorbent material to be disposed of at an authorised site. Do not pour concentrate or contaminated waste to drains/watercourses.
