Protect from freezing.	Acids. SDS transport notes corrosive to copper, copper compounds, copper alloys and rubber, and reacts violently with acids. Keep away from food/drink and other incompatible chemicals.	Store locked up, cool, tightly closed, upright, in original labelled container, in a well-ventilated COSHH store with secondary containment. Keep away from acids and incompatible materials. Protect from freezing.	Ensure current SDS, RAMS and COSHH are available. Restrict access to trained staff. Inspect containers regularly. Provide spill kit, eyewash access and correct PPE near point of use.

Floor care - polish stripping only. Dilution: 1:10 (10%) per RAMS. Do not use neat unless specifically authorised. Apply using controlled methods and avoid generating spray/mist.	Read label/SDS before use. Dilute carefully into labelled container. Never mix with acids or other chemicals. No eating, drinking or smoking. Wash hands after use; remove contaminated clothing. Use wet floor signage and exclude unauthorised persons.	PPE: chemical-resistant nitrile gloves, eye protection/safety glasses or goggles, protective clothing and safety footwear/boots. Consider face protection where splash risk is high. Use only outdoors or in a well-ventilated area.	Ensure good ventilation; avoid breathing vapours/spray. Keep bystanders away. Use correct dilution/equipment and cap container after use. Clean spills immediately with absorbent material. Avoid drains/watercourses. Do not proceed if PPE or ventilation is unavailable.
