OUR SERVICES

Physical Therapy

Physical therapy (PT) services aim to improve an individual's strength, balance, coordination, and pain to facilitate the most independence with functional mobility and best quality of life.

Occupational Therapy

Occupational therapy (OT) services support an individual's ability to engage in everyday activities and acquire skills to promote function. Occupational therapy uses a variety of approaches to assist with activities of daily living, sensory based behaviors, functional play, fine motor skills, eye-hand coordination, core strength and handwriting.

Speech Therapy

Speech-Language Therapy (ST) services focus on enhancing or restoring communication skills. This includes evaluating and treating receptive and expressive language disorders, speech sound disorders, stuttering, oral motor function, and more. Services also include assessment and treatment for alternative communication systems.
