General Permit Requirements

Specification

City of Burlington Building Permits:

All permits or licenses necessary for the new construction or alterations to the structure must be obtained and paid for by the Contractor before starting work. Contractors and Subcontractors are responsible for obtaining any progress or final inspections from the Building Department. Failure to call for required inspections or proceeding without inspection may result in suspension from future bidding. Two copies of all permits are required, one shall be publicly displayed at the job site for all interested parties concerned, the second shall be on file at Southeast Iowa Regional Planning Commission. The Southeast Iowa Regional Planning Commission has the right to inspect work in progress. These inspections need not be announced in advance.

Recover flat roof using EPDM; single ply with cement.

This work is for flat roof on north side of house which also wraps around to the east side a little bit. This work excludes all other flat roofs on the house.

Tear off all existing roof covering down to decking. Inspect and replace defective decking to match. Prepare surface by sweeping and removing all loose material. Use 45 mil EPDM. Fully adhere with adhesive specified by the EPDM manufacturer. If lap splices are required, use lap splice cement specified by the EPDM manufacturer. Lap joints to be a minimum of 4".

The current roof leaks in several places due to nails penetrating the surface, improper use of produces, improper sealing of joints, etc. There are two roof drains which are not properly sealed; be sure to use products manufactured for this purpose and seal them properly. There are two roof vents which use improper products; be sure to use products manufactured for this purpose. Be sure to properly flash all junctions between flat roofing and siding to make sure water does not enter the structure.

Install 1/2" drywall; tape, mud, prime and paint.

For ceiling in first floor bathroom, NW corner of the house. The ceiling has been damaged due to leaking roof.

Remove crown molding. At option of contractor, remove damaged plywood ceiling, or leave ceiling in place if dry and no danger of molding. Install 1/2" drywall to joists or studs with screws, as per manufacturers recommendations. Tape and finish 2 coats. Reinstall crown molding or install equivalent new. Protect all surfaces and materials (e.g., floor, cabinets, fixtures) which are not to be painted. Unless specifically called, do not paint any varnished or stained wood surfaces. Apply primer coat followed by two finish coats of latex paint, color and sheen match rest of bathroom as closely as possible

4 Install 1/4 " presswood panel.

In first floor bathroom in NW corner of the house, the paneling on the north wall is damaged from the roof leak.

Carefully remove paneling on top half of the north wall. Prepare wall surface to receive new paneling. Wall surface to be smooth and free of defects. Install standard size 1/4" presswood paneling. Use matching panel nails. Caulk joints. Paint to match color and sheen of the rest of the bathroom as closely as possible.

5 Wrap areas of window trim with coil stock.

For the following upperstory windows:

- South side, 5 upperstory windows.
- West side, 2 upperstory windows.
- North side, 3 upperstory windows.
- East side, 3 upperstory windows.

When upper windows were installed, coil stock was not installed properly. Areas of bare wood are exposed. Weather can get under coil stock in places.

Wrap areas of exposed wood of exterior trim with aluminum prefinished to match trim color. Finished product should be professional and workmanlike, and weather-tight.

6 Remove and reinstall storm window.

The east storm window on the south side of the house was not installed properly. The side rails are pushed apart a little too much, causing the bottom pain to not fit properly in the track. Remove window and reinstall properly.
