Permits are not believed to be required for this project; check with the City of Burlington.

All permits or licenses necessary for the new construction or alterations to the structure must be obtained and paid for by the Contractor before starting work. Contractors and Subcontractors are responsible for obtaining any progress or final inspections from the Building Department. Failure to call for required inspections or proceeding without inspection may result in suspension from future bidding. Two copies of all permits are required, one shall be publicly displayed at the job site for all interested parties concerned, the second shall be on file at Southeast Iowa Regional Planning Commission. The Southeast Iowa Regional Planning Commission has the right to inspect work in progress. These inspections need not be announced in advance.

2 Install vinyl replacement thermopane double hung window. No trim.

The following 25 windows to be replaced:

- West/front 13 windows, including 2 on the porch interor, 10 on the front porch, and 3 above the porch.
- South 6 windows, including 3 in the bay window, and 3 on the main house. Do not replace any windows on the rear addition nor the window filled with insulation on the upper story above the rear addition.
- East/rear 2 windows, including the east window in the attic dormer, and the small window on the north face above the rear addition. Do not replace any windows on the rear addition.
- North 4 windows, including 3 double hung windows and the fixed window.

Remove and dispose storm windows on windows to be replace. Install aluminum coil stock to cover exposed wood where storm windows were. Coil stock should be installed in a workman like manner and in a way that seals water out.

Remove and dispose of sash and parting beads. Carefully remove interior stop, preserving for re-use. Remove pulley assembly and weights, if present, and fill cavity with fiberglass insulation. Cover pulley opening with coil stock or flashing. Caulk seams of weight cavity cover. Provide and install a prefabricated, double-hung, double glazed/thermopane, vinyl replacement window, including self-storing screen. Caulk blindstop and the edges to seal. Reinstall interior stops and cault tight against window assembly. Remove all labels from glass. Clean glass pane.

3 Install Insulated Steel Door, complete with lite.

For rear/east door:

Specification

Remove existing door. Install steel door and frame assembly, complete with lockset and deadbolt all hardware including doorstop. All exterior door locks to a house or suite to be keyed-alike. Door shall fit existing opening. Reduction in opening size shall not be permitted. Door shall have at least one lite of minimum 24" x 36". Unit shall be primed and painted one color, customer has choice of color. Repair all damage to walls and trim.

Product Standard: Stanley, Peachtree or equal quality.

4 Install combination storm door.

For storm door on east side of house:

Install vinyl or aluminum storm door with continuous hinge. Door to have combination storm and screen panel in passing tracks or shall be equipped with removable panels. Door to be equipped with latching handle, bottom sweep, pneumatic closer, and anti-wind check chain. Door to fit opening completely. Reducing the door opening size shall not be permitted. Adjust and test closing operation.

5 Front concrete stairs and private sidewalk.

Remove and dispose of existing stone stairs and concrete pads connecting stairs to private and public sidewalk. Remove and dispose of the private sidewalk along the west side of the house, stopping where the sidewalk turns the corner around the house. Excavate 4" below new steps and sidewalk and dispose of excavation material. Install 4" compacted clean gravel to provide well-drained base for new stairs and sidewalk. Form and cast new concrete stairs with a riser height of not less than four inches and not greater than seven inches, and with a tread depth of approximately 11 inches per building code. Form and cast concrete new sidewalk along west side of house as necessary to connect new steps to to porch steps. Form and cast a concrete pad as necessary to connect new steps to the public sidewalk. Concrete must have at least 2 bars of #4 rebar running the length of the steps, 1 bar of #4 rebar reinforcing the point of each step, and must be at least 4" thick in thinnest areas between steps. Provide broom finish. All forms must be straight and level. Call for forms to be inspected at least 24 hours before pouring. Concrete shall be 3000psi mix and shall contain sound, coarse aggregate of 1" or less. Admixtures are to be added at the plant, not at the job site and shall be identified on the shipping ticket.

Install wood hand rail on one side of new stairs.

Install one 2" x 4" pressure-treated, preformed V-groove, code compliant hand rail or other code-compliant handrail 32" height above stair nosing supported by 4" x 4" preservative-treated posts sufficiently secured to the side of the new stairs. Rail to be free from cracks, splinters, and rough edges. Rail to be sufficiently supported in the mid-run of the rail to stabilize the rail without interrupting the continuity of the rail.

Obtain appropriate right-of-way permits from the City of Burlington (Scott Peters, 319-753-8176 ext 419). Bonding may be necessary per city requirements, but the City has expressed a willingness to waive bonding. Follow all requirements of the City of Burlington. Locate utilities per lowa law before excavation.
