### 1 General Permit Requirements

City of Keokuk Building and Mechanical Permits, State of Iowa Electrical Permit: All permits or licenses necessary for the new construction or alterations to the structure specified below must be obtained and paid for by the Contractor before starting work. Contractors and Subcontractors are responsible for obtaining any progress or final inspections from the Building Department/State of Iowa. Failure to call for required inspections or proceeding without inspection may result in suspension from future bidding. Two copies of all permits are required, one shall be publicly displayed at the job site for all interested parties concerned, the second shall be on file at Southeast Iowa Regional Planning Commission. The Southeast Iowa Regional Planning Commission has the right to inspect work in progress. These inspections need not be announced in advance.

Install vinyl siding, with fanfold, wrap all trim/fascia/soffit. complete

Install on entire exterior, including wrapping all cornice and corner with minimum .040 gauge vinyl siding. Remove and install new fascia and soffitting.

Install house wrap over brick structure to provide rain barrier and proper flashing around windows/doors/other openings. Install furring strips over brick structure. Install foam insulation over brick structure of same thickness between furring strips and around window/door trim. All doors and windows must be trimmed with furring strips, cased, and properly flashed under house wrap. Remove siding on rear structure and install fanfold insulation over the structure.

For the lea- to stairwell covering on the rear of the house, repair the wall framing to prepare it to receive siding on the exterior. Install sheathing as necessary. Install siding on the exterior of the lean to addition, and install siding over the main house structure. No need to install siding on the interior of the lean-to structure; it is OK to leave open studs.

Aluminum shall be installed on windows and door trim, soffit, and all porch ceilings. Preformed fascia trim shall be used where applicable. Inside and outside corner posts, service meter blocks, replacement vents, plumbing and electrical blocks in matching color shall be used as required. Caulk all seams with silicone caulk., beads not to exceed 3/8". Siding must carry a nonprorated, transferable manufacturer's limited lifetime warranty. All installation procedures, including spacing, shall be in accordance with manufacturer's specifications. Owner to have choice of color. NOTE: You must have a licensed electrician remove and reinstall the electric conductors attached to the house.

3 Replace gutters & downspouts.

Remove all old gutters. Inspect for rotted fascia boards or rafters. Request change order if needed. Install 5", K-Type or ogee, seamless, .027" or thicker aluminum gutter and accessories. Gutters to extend full length of roof edge drip line. Contractor shall furnish and install all needed outlet tubes and custom miters. Support gutters with galvanized steel gutter spikes through ferrules or K style gutter hangers clipped into the front lip of the gutter and screwed through the back of the gutter and into the fascia board, spaced not more than 6' apart. Maintain proper pitch of 1/2" per 10'. Seal all gutter seams with gutter sealer and secure each seam with a sheet metal screw or rivet. Remove all old downspouts. Install matching 4" downspout and accessories. Fasten downspouts to wall with straps every 6 vertical feet. Connect into existing crocks with PVC connector. If there are no crocks then splash blocks shall be provided. Color to match existing.

Install vinyl replacement thermopane double hung window. No trim.
Remove and replace windows. Some windows are original, some have been replaced.
Perform work necessary to replace all windows. Review openings and repair as necessary.

The upper front window was haphazardly replaced and enlarged. The opening may need repaired and probably needs a new lintel. The brick wall is exposed on both the interior and exterior so inspection for bidding and repairing should be practical and efficient. Review and repair as necessary.

For all windows, interior trim need not be improved.

Remove and dispose of sash and parting beads. Remove and dispose of all storm windows and the storm door used as storm window on upper rear window. Carefully remove interior stop, preserving for re-use. Remove pulley assembly and weights, if present, and fill cavity with fiberglass insulation. Cover pulley opening with coil stock or flashing. Caulk seams of weight cavity cover. Provide and install a prefabricated, double-hung, double glazed/thermopane, vinyl replacement window, including self-storing screen. Caulk blindstop and the edges to seal. Reinstall interior stops and cault tight against window assembly. Remove all labels from glass. Clean glass pane. Note: If there is any conflict in specifications, the window shall be installed according to manufacturers instructions unless otherwise indicated by the agency. Warranty is to be given to the Homeowner.

PRODUCT STANDARD: Fusion-welded, low - E glass with low-conductance spacer a minimum of 3/4" and a U-factor rating of 0.30 or below; and a lifetime limited warranty. Simonton Prism series; ThermaStar by Pella®; or other equal quality window approved by the agency.

Windows must have overridable opening limiters to prevent accidental falls.

5 Install Insulated Steel Door, complete with lite.

Install new front and rear doors.

Remove existing door. Install steel door and frame assembly, complete with lockset and deadbolt all hardware including doorstop. All exterior door locks to a house or suite to be keyed-alike. Door shall fit existing opening. Reduction in opening size shall not be permitted. Door shall have at least one lite of minimum 24" x 36". Unit shall be primed and painted one color, customer has choice of color. Repair all damage from installation to walls and trim, but no need to improve trim/walls beyond existing condition.

6 Install 40 gallon hot water heater. 220V

Install a 40 gallon, glass-lined high-recovery hot water tank. Tank shall be insulated to R10 minimum. Include temperature and pressure relief valve, discharge tube to within 4 inches of the floor, Run properly sized wire to point of use disconnect if applicable, attach to tank in proper conduit. Water supply line into tank to have fullway valve installed if not already present. All work to comply with current applicable codes. Remove and dispose of old heater if present in an approved manner. Tank shall have a minimum 5 year warranty.

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7 Install 100 amp service. Complete

Dispose of old electric service and panels. Install a residential, 100 amp, 3 wire electric service. Install a new mast through the roof to raise the height of the service drop. Install an exterior disconnect. Include a main disconnect, 24 circuit panel board, circuit breakers, meter socket, service head, and service ground rod & wire. Connect all loads to breakers. Label all breakers. Balance circuits to provide a minimum of two general lighting circuits. New installation shall have a GFCI receptacle located directly below panel, and a light source sufficient to illuminate panel.

8 Replace furnace with 92+ unit.

Remove existing furnace and dispose of in an approved manner. Prepare heat loss analysis and replace the furnace with new unit sized as indicated by heat loss calculation. Give copy of calculation report to Agency before beginning installation. Include connections to existing gas line. Include thermostat, filters, fan, plenum controls, and flue pipe. Gas shutoff valve must be on vertical piping, approximate to the electrical disconnect and readily accessible. System to be installed on a separate power circuit. Supply operating manual, operating instruction to the owner and one year call back. Replacement unit shall be properly sized in accordance with ACCA's Manual J or other recognized methodology. Data for heat load/loss calculations shall be based on post-rehabilitation conditions, and shall be documented. Minimum efficiency rating AFUE will be 92 percent.
