



Have you heard?

The National Eucharistic Revival 2022-2024 is the joyful, expectant, grassroots response of the entire Catholic Church in the U.S. to this divine invitation. Each week we will share an image and short reflection on the Eucharist for you to share with your family. One of the beautiful parts of Catholic life is Eucharistic Adoration. The host, which is Jesus, is placed in a gold vessel called a monstrance (monstrare is Latin for "to show"), and that is placed on the altar. Adoration gives us the opportunity to come and pray before Jesus: to tell him our joys and sorrows, to ask for his help, to thank him for what he has done for us, or simply to adore his greatness. The other types of prayer flow from Adoration, the recognition that God himself is in front of us.


