A COMPASSIONATE GOD

Today's reading from the book of Wisdom presents an image of a patient God who "rebuke[s] offenders little by little" (Wisdom 12:2), an image endorsed by the psalmist, singing of how the LORD is "slow to anger and of great kindness, and compassionate toward all his works" (Psalm 145:8,9). The crowd with Jesus, however, grumbles when they see Jesus' kindness and compassion extended to Zacchaeus, who was not just a tax collector, but the "chief tax collector"—a title that surely emphasizes his standing as a sinner to be scorned. In the second reading, Saint Paul urges the Thessalonians to be "worthy" of God's calling, so that "the name of our Lord Jesus may be glorified in you" (2 Thessalonians 1:12); such people, unlike the crowd in the Gospel, would rejoice at Zacchaeus's determination to change his life after encountering Jesus.

All are invited to come and support our fellow parishioners. They will be most grateful for you for your presence.

*The Red Cross is grateful for the opportunity to work with St. Bernardine in the mission to save lives and promotion of community health through blood donation. We had 22 registered donors and collected **21 units of life-saving blood**, and this will directly impact the lives of up to **63 patients** as they battle cancer, receive a transfusion for a blood disorder or undergo surgery. In 2022, St Bernardine of Siena blood drives have collected 66 units of blood, which can impact the care of up to 198 patients. One of the biggest highlights was the **7 First Time Donors** that donated at the blood drive. New donors are so important to the Red Cross as many will find the experience rewarding and will come out and do it again!*

Be Aware of Airbag Dangers for Young Children



An airbag can save your life, but for a young, small child, air bags pose a serious risk. All new cars have front seat airbags, so be aware of where your child should sit in the car to be safe for his or her age. All children in rear-facing car seats must ride in the back seat. Even in a low-speed crash, the airbag can inflate and hit a car seat in the front seat, causing serious injury. 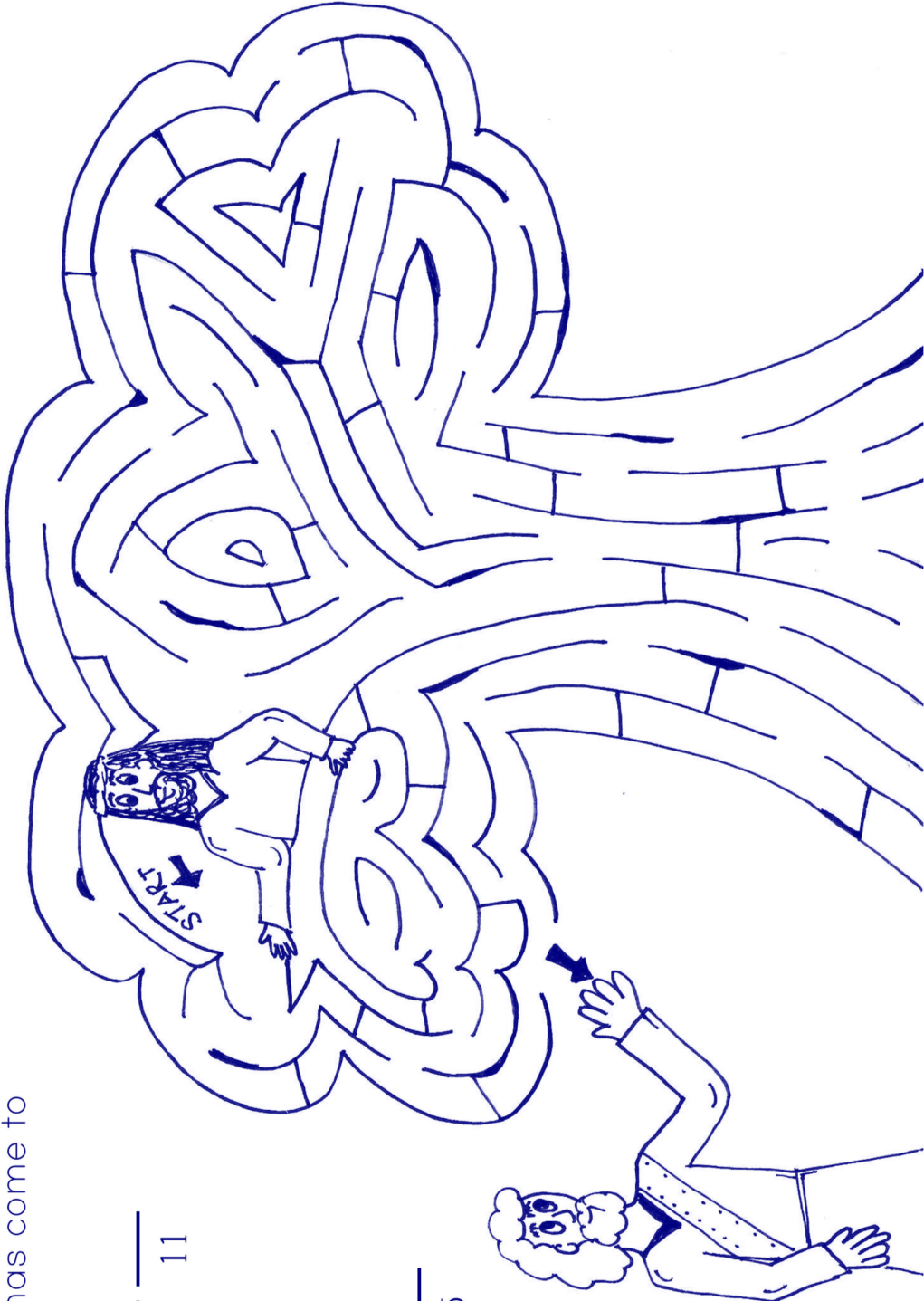

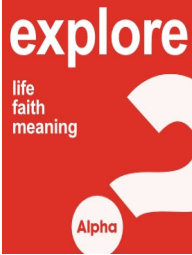

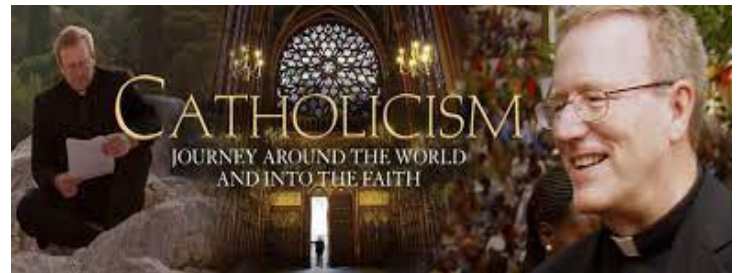
