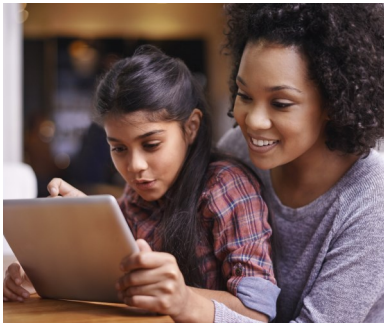

CITE Services

Community Integrated Training & Education



CITE is a contracted resource available to families with a child, age 3—22, who qualifies through the Warren County Board of Developmental Disabilities.

CITE services are provided by our highly trained professional staff. All of our team members have specialized and advanced training in working with children and youth with developmental disabilities and include licensed and/or degreed staff with backgrounds in psychology, early childhood development, elementary, secondary and special education, autism, and other human service fields. We also understand the impact trauma and chronic stress has on the child and the family.

Collaboration is the key to success.

The key to our success is that CITE staff experience challenges in real time with caregivers, and are there in the moment to model interventions and to coach parents through the implementation of strategies.



Our services include:

- Skill development in a variety of areas: communication, social, daily living, and behavior.
- Development of intervention plans based on diagnosis specific best practice, including Autism Spectrum Disorders
- Behavior support and intervention plan development, including behavioral and functional assessment, intervention plan development, and intensive coaching
- Task assessment to determine strengths and needs within targeted skill development areas
- Parent training and education, including direct coaching and consultation
- General program consultation with school teams and staff training
