

## The Musilli & Hoover Lifelong Learning Small Grants Fund for Literacy

In recognition of the continuing quest for knowledge and the importance of the written word, the Ralph E. Musilli and Lynne Hoover Lifelong Learning Small Grants Fund is designed to support public library and related programming in the areas of literacy, children and teens, and continuing education. Each application is reviewed by a committee, and limited funding is available for each project.

Funding examples may include, but are not limited to: early literacy, elementary and summer reading programs, tutoring, resourcing bookmobiles and book clubs, and expanding library collections.

Each application will be reviewed by the committee for determination and presented to the Anchor Bay Community Foundation Board of Directors for approval. Applications must be submitted at least one month before the program/project funding is needed to allow for ample time for review.

Funding is <u>only</u> available for programs in the greater Anchor Bay community.

Feedback for the grant/program is required.
