Paradise Hot Springs waters are naturally heated by the Arenal Volcano. They're pure and without any kind of added chemicals. Water's geological origin can be telluric or magmatic. In the case of Paradise, the water is telluric, which means it's young water, rainwater that is filtered through the earth and circulates through different depths, gathering minerals and gaining temperature when making contact with very hot materials.
