Day # 1 - Sunday, September 27, 2026

Begin this picturesque journey by traveling via deluxe motorcoach across the Midwest and into Ohio for your overnight accommodations. Sit back, enjoy the ride and meet your new traveling companions. Dinner is included and the rest of your evening is at leisure. (D)



Day # 2 - Monday, September 28, 2026

With Vermont being the top US producer of maple syrup, we have scheduled a stop to see how this "Green Mountain Gold" is produced. We check into our Killington, VT hotel for a two-night stay. Dinner is included this evening. (B,D)



Day #4 - Wednesday, September 30, 2026

After breakfast, enjoy a full day of Vermont touring, starting at the Vermont Granite Museum in Barre—"Granite Capital of the World"—with over 40 exhibits in a restored 1895 plant, then visit Hope Cemetery to see its famous granite memorials. Lunch is a buffet at the Trapp Family Lodge, followed by a tour, including an overview of the von Trapp family story vs. the movie version. The day ends with a narrated tour of Mendon Mountain Orchards, including samples and the farm store. Dinner is on your own. (B, L)

Day #5 - Thursday, October 1, 2026

After breakfast, we travel into New Hampshire and stop in Littleton, a gateway to the White Mountains, to visit Chutters General Store, famous for its 112 feet of candy jars. We then board the Loon Mountain Gondola and ascend 1,738 vertical feet, enjoying breathtaking views of the surrounding White Mountains. In the evening, we board the Turkey Dinner Train on the Winnepesaukee Railroad, savoring a meal while taking in panoramic views of Lake Winnepesaukee at the foothills of the mountains. After the train ride, we check into our Concord, NH hotel. (B, D)



Day #6 - Friday, October 2, 2026

A hearty continental breakfast is provided this morning in anticipation of our Maine touring. Our local guide joins us for a Kennebunkport tour. Learn about this popular summer resort Maine town. Drive by the Bush's summer home & Sea Captain's mansion. Lunch is on your own at Dock Square, downtown Kennebunkport. A trip to Maine would not be the same without a visit to the world-famous LL Bean, an American privately held retail company founded in 1912. Overnight will be in Portland, ME with an included complete down east Lobsta Bake dinner. (B,D)

Day # 7 - Saturday, October 3, 2026

Today has been set aside to explore some of the wonders of Maine. A local guide will join us for a Portland City Tour. We will learn about Portland's diverse history and architecture. The childhood home of Henry Wadsworth Longfellow and the bustling Old Port are just a few of the landmarks you will see as you travel from city streets to rocky coasts. Photo stop at the Portland Harbor Lighthouse which provides us with great views across the bay. This area was home to two gigantic shipyards during WWII where liberty ships were built. Lunch is on your own at Portland's Old Port. We have arranged for a narrated scenic seasonal cruise, Casco Bay Boat Cruises. You will pass lovely island cottages on the shorelines of Little and Great Diamond Island and Peaks Island. Dinner is included. (B,D)

Day # 8 - Sunday, October 4, 2026

There is breakfast to enjoy before you begin to travel west toward home. As you leave the New England area we make one last stop in Stockbridge, MA at the Norman Rockwell Museum. Here you will see the world's largest collection of Rockwell drawings and paintings. Our overnight accommodations are in Binghamton, NY area. Dinner is on your own. (B)

Day # 9 - Monday, October 5, 2026

Your deluxe motorcoach is ready and waiting. Today we make our way into Pennsylvania and our last overnight stay. Dinner is included this evening. (B,D)
