4 Days August 4-7, 2026

Day 1 – Port Clinton, OH – Today, travel takes you to Port Clinton, OH where you enjoy a three-night stay at the Fairfield Inn. Dinner is included this evening at a local restaurant. **(D)**

Day 2 - Jet Express to Put-In-Bay – Island Transportation Train & Tour w/Lunch Voucher – African Safari Wildlife Park – After breakfast at the hotel, board the Jet Express to Put-In-Bay and a visit to the island. It is one of the fastest ferries on Lake Erie, taking 25 minutes to travel between Port Clinton and Put-In-Bay. Often called the “Key West of the North,” Put-In-Bay features a lively entertainment scene, historic sites, and breathtaking water views.

Included today is the Island Transportation Train. Enjoy a one-hour narrated historical tour around 80% of the island with various stops along the route. (Train tours are not ADA accessible). Island Transportation will transport you to downtown Put-In-Bay where you can enjoy lunch at the various restaurants. (Vouchers can be used at Mossbacks, Hooligans, Chicken Patio, Boardwalk, The Brewery, and Dair Isle)

This afternoon, you will catch the Jet Express back to the mainland. Visit the African Safari Wildlife Park for a unique wildlife experience. Drive through the park and then proceed to the walk-through area, Safari Junction, for a closer look at other animals. The park also hosts educational programs and animal encounters. End the day with dinner at a local restaurant. **(B,L,D)**


Day 3 – Liberty Aviation Museum – Merry-Go-Round Museum – Lakeside Chautauqua – Marblehead Lighthouse – After breakfast, visit the Liberty Aviation Museum and learn about the aviation industry. Along with aircrafts, the museum also has a large collection of military jeeps and tanks. Many of these artifacts are believed to be used during WWI and WWII. You will also be able to see some military costumes on display.

Next, enjoy a fun and relaxed atmosphere as you tour the Merry-Go-Round Museum and learn about the history and art of the Carousel. Have your smiles ready as you relive your childhood excitement as you climb aboard the working "fully restored" Allan Herschel Carousel with the band organ playing. Watch carvers as they bring neglected carousel pieces back to their full beauty. Take time to enjoy a ride on the Carousel.

This afternoon, visit Lakeside Chautauqua for shopping and lunch on your own. Stroll through the charming streets of Lakeside, a private community and census-designated place in Ottawa County, Ohio on the shores of Lake Erie. It was formed in 1873 by members of the Methodist Church and remains a church-affiliated vacation resort and United Methodist Annual Conference site. Located just west of the village of Marblehead, the community is approximately one square mile in size. The entire community is listed on the National Register of Historic Places as the Lakeside Historic District. Free shuttle service runs all day.

Then, stop for a photo-op at the Marblehead Lighthouse. This historic landmark and the oldest continuously operating lighthouse on the American side of the Great Lakes. It stands 65 feet tall and has been guiding sailors along the rocky shores of the Marblehead Peninsula since 1822. The lighthouse is made of local limestone and has a two-story keeper's house nearby. Return to the hotel to freshen up before dinner tonight at a local restaurant. **(B,D)**

Day 4 – Oak Haven Belgians - Depart for Home – After breakfast at the hotel, visit the Oak Haven Belgians Horse Farm. Established in 1992 by Dr. Michael Stone, the farm features an extensive breeding program for Belgians where they also train and enter their horses into hitch and cart competitions across the country. Through selective breeding and training, his horses are recognized as being one of the top Belgian breeders in the country! Get up close and personal with these majestic and gentle giants, with a group experience at Oak Haven Belgians. Following your visit, depart for home. **(B)**
