In the evening, gather for a traditional **Door County fish boil dinner at Pelletier's Restaurant in Fish Creek**, a beloved regional dining experience. The night concludes with a live performance at the **Peninsula Players Theatre**, America's oldest professional resident summer theater, before returning to the hotel.

included lunch, where you’ll learn about artisan cheesemaking and sample delicious goat cheeses. In the afternoon, visit **Ziegler Winery in Malone** for a relaxing wine tasting surrounded by scenic countryside. Later, we travel to **Jim & Linda’s Supper Club in Malone** for a classic Wisconsin supper club dinner. Afterward, check into the **Radisson Hotel in Fond du Lac, Wisconsin** for the evening
