Learning Together, Growing Stronger

To kickoff off our new Family Feature series, we're proud to introduce Shalanda and her son, Landon. As an active and engaged family in our program, they represent the strength, love, and determination that we hope to see in our families everyday. Curious to hear her perspective in her own words, I asked Shalanda a few questions about the impact the program has had so far.

- How long have you been with L4L? This is my first year with Launch,

I became apart of the organization in August.

- How did you hear about L4L? I discovered the program while strolling through Facebook after searching for programs for boys. I then visited the Launch website and read more about it, which I knew I wanted my son to become involved.
- How has your son grown during the program? Since joining the program, my son has grown significantly. He is now able to communicate more effectively and engage socially. Although he appears shy at first, he warms up over time and is expressing himself much more confidently.
- How has the program helped/supported you? Growing up in the foster care system, I always aimed to create a complete family structure for my children. While that hasn't fully been the case, the program has been an incredible support by providing resources and guidance that go beyond what I could offer on my own as a mother-support that a father might traditionally provide. It has also given my son opportunities to interact and build friendships with other boys his age from diverse backgrounds, helping him grow socially and emotionally.

- What would you like to brag on your son about/his accomplishments? Honestly, I could brag about everything he does good and bad lol. If I had to choose one thing, I'd say it's him becoming his own person-gaining confidence, independence, and a sense of identity.

Mentor Spotlight

Meet Tyler Rood

Kicking off our Mentor Spotlight series, I interviewed one of our incredible mentors to hear what inspires him to pour into the young men in our program. Here is what Tyler Rood had to say.

- 1. How long have you been a mentor? I've been a mentor since July of 2023 or almost 3
- 2. Why did you decide to become a mentor? I wanted to put my time into something that actually mattered. And the way I landed at LAUNCH was almost accidental. I got an HOA violation, jumped on the neighborhood Facebook page ready to stir the pot, and while I was typing up a full rant, I saw David's post looking for mentors. It stopped me. Pouring into a young man felt like a much better use of my energy than arguing with neighbors, so I closed the Facebook tab and applied.
- 3. What have you learned through mentoring? I've learned it really is the size of the fight in the dog, not the size of the dog in the fight. Love, consistency, and steady delivery go a long way. When you show up the same way every time, slow down, and actually listen, trust starts to build and that is the real growth.

Having difficult talks with your son should happen sooner than you might think, expert says

This article emphasizes that parents should begin challenging, but crucial conversations with their sons earlier than they may feel comfortable. Experts argue that topics such as consent, technology use, substance use, and emotional well-being are best addressed proactively while relationships are still open, and that waiting too long can make these conversations feel contentious. Whereas beginning the talks in a calm, ongoing way helps set the tone for trust and openness. Begin early. These talks work best when they are calm, ongoing and part of everyday connections rather than big confrontations. Framing the conversation in a calm, comfortable, and nonjudgmental manner encourages and strengthens trust.
