1. Touring Difficulty: Moderate. Is this tour right for you?

The tour is not sold or offered as ADA-compliant. Aside from the beautiful sites and lots of fun on the tour, there is important information you should consider:

- Although portage service are provided, you may need to carry your luggage on occasion.
- You will be boarding and getting off the bus 5-6 times per day, during touring days.
- Some of the days will entail several hours of walking or standing for 20-30 minutes, while listening to the guide's explanations.
- Some of the days will entail bus rides of 4-6 hours with bathroom breaks.
- The bus on the tour is not ADA-compliant and may not have a bathroom. It is air-conditioned.
- It is possible to skip sites and stay in the hotel, but there will be no refund for unused entrance fees.
- Normal daytime temperatures are in the 60's-70's, while evenings will likely be in the 40's – 50's.
- Food allergies will be noted and forwarded but may not be properly addressed.

- **Hotels – 9 Nights – Standard Rooms (unless mentioned otherwise):**
 - Sep 04 – Sep 08: 4 Nights [Hotel am Konzerthaus](#) or similar – Vienna (Deluxe Rooms)
 - Sep 08 – Sep 09: 1 Night [Hotel Weitzer](#) or similar – Graz (Classic Superior Rooms)
 - Sep 09 – Sep 11: 2 Nights [Hotel aDLERS](#) or similar – Innsbruck
 - Sep 11 – Sep 13: 2 Nights [Hotel Altstadt](#) or similar - Salzburg (Superior Rooms)

8. Payment Schedule, Terms and Conditions:

- A. By paying, you signify that you represent the travel party and have read, understood, and agree to all sections of this brochure and Disclaimer below.
- B. Payments are only accepted by check, wire transfer or Zelle, except for the initial deposits which can be paid by credit card, with an added 3% agency handling fee.
- C. Check payments should be sent to arrive by the due date to Scopia LLC, 8916 N Iroquois Road, Bayside, WI 53217. Please add "Austria 2026" to the memo line.

D. Important dates to remember:

- a. **Upon Registration/Confirmation:** A non-refundable deposit of \$100 per person (credit card or check). This deposit will be reimbursed if we do not have a minimum of 10 participants registered by the deadline.
- b. **May 1, 2026:** If we reach 10 participants, a second non-refundable deposit of \$1,000 per person is due and is non-refundable (check, ACH or Zelle).
- c. **July 15, 2026:** Final payment is due and is non-refundable (check, wire transfer or Zelle).

E. Refund periods (if you cancel):

- a. Cancel by May 1, 2026: \$100 cancellation fee per person.
- b. Cancel from May 1, 2026 to July 15, 2026: \$1,100 cancellation fee per person.
- c. Cancel any time after July 15, 2026: All payments are non-refundable.

F. Cancellation of the tour by Scopia LLC:

- a. In the event the tour needs to be cancelled by May 1, 2026 due to insufficient registrations, all deposits will be refunded in full.
- b. After May 1, 2026: Should the tour be cancelled due to reasons or events beyond the control of Scopia LLC (force majeure): Scopia LLC will work with tour suppliers for possible reimbursement of payments made to the suppliers. Amounts received by Scopia LLC will be reimbursed to tour participants less \$300 per person.

G. Important note: Payment and refund schedule and/or amounts may change if certain suppliers require deposits (refundable or non-refundable) which are not listed above.

- H. There is no refund for unused services while traveling.
- I. Scopia LLC has the right to refuse participation to any registrant, for any reason and without the need to disclose such reasoning.

 - b. All rates are subject to change without advance notice until final payment has been made.



9. Tour Itinerary:

The tour itinerary is subject to change according to the discretion of the guide and/or the local tour operator. Changes may be due to weather, security or other considerations. Meals included each day are listed as B, L, D.

Friday, September 4: Arrival in Vienna (D)

Each party will arrive in Vienna by plane or train, meet the local driver and transfer to the hotel. After checking in, the rest of the day is free. In the evening, we take a short walk to a nearby restaurant for a welcome dinner, a great opportunity to get acquainted. **OVERNIGHT - VIENNA**

Saturday, September 5: Classical Vienna and Apple Strudel Workshop (B)

Enjoy a panoramic city tour on the famous Ringstrasse to see the State Opera House, Museum of Fine Arts and Natural History Museum, the Hofburg, Parliament, Burgtheater and City Hall. Then, it's time for some fun at a workshop dedicated to making Apple Strudels, one of Austria's culinary gifts to the world! Then, some free time for lunch on your own and independent exploration. The tour then continues walking through the heart of the city, visiting Saint Stephan's Cathedral (E), Vienna's gothic emblem. The evening is free for dinner on own. **OVERNIGHT - VIENNA**

Sunday, September 6: Imperial Vienna and Jewish Vienna and (B)

Explore the beauties of Imperial Vienna, starting with the Belvedere Palace, former residence of Prince Eugene of Savoy. Continue to Schönbrunn Palace (E), set in a park with one of the world's oldest zoos. The castle and its outbuildings, predominantly "Rococo" style, have more than 1400 rooms.

After free time for lunch, the afternoon will be dedicated to the history of Vienna's Jewish community, one of the largest in Europe at the turn of the previous century. Although Jews have lived in Vienna since the Middle Ages, a very dark portion of Austria's history took place before and during the Holocaust. Over 33,000 Jews were rounded up and deported to concentration camps, most of them were never to be heard from again. These days, the Austrian government recognizes this dark past, educates about the holocaust and memorializes the Jewish community that once existed in Vienna.

We will see the Jewish Museum (outside), stones of memory, the former Jewish Quarter and the synagogue in Seitenstettengasse (outside). We hear what the Graben has to do with the Jewish community in England, about the oldest mint master in Vienna, and end with a visit to the Holocaust memorial completed in 2022. Dinner this evening is on your own. **OVERNIGHT - VIENNA**

Monday, September 7: Wachau – Austria's Wine Country Along the Danube (B, L)

Today we head out of Vienna to the beautiful Wachau, a stretch of the Danube Valley between Melk and Krems. Wachau is an interesting place to visit for architecture (monasteries, castles, ruins), urban design and agriculture. Some of Austria's best wineries are located here.

We stop at Melk to visit the magnificent 11th century Benedictine Abbey (E) and enjoy a short cruise on the Danube to Dürnstein, including lunch. It was here that King Richard the Lionheart was imprisoned while waiting for his ransom to arrive from England. There will be some time to stroll through the romantic alleys of the town before we return to Vienna for a free evening. **OVERNIGHT VIENNA**

Tuesday, September 8: Vienna to Graz via Heiligenkreuz, Mayerling and Baden (B, L, D)

Today we depart Vienna and head south to the famous [Wienerwald](#), a beautiful, forested area surrounding the city. We visit the former hunting lodge (now only a memorial chapel) of crown prince Rudolph. Continuing, we reach the 12th century [Cistercian Abbey of Heiligenkreuz](#) (E) and drive to the Roman city of Baden, famous for its thermal springs and the “Rosarium” rose garden. Lunch will be enjoyed enroute at a local restaurant before arriving in the city of Graz, where we check in at the hotel.

In the afternoon, we explore [Graz](#) with a local guide. It has one of the best-preserved old town centers in Europe, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Dinner will be served in the hotel. **OVERNIGHT – GRAZ**

Wednesday, September 9: Graz to Innsbruck via Bad Ischel or via Altaussee (B, L, D)

We depart Graz for Innsbruck through [Bad Ischel](#), cultural center of the Salzkammergut, a health resort with a feel for the former imperial times. The city was chosen by Emperor Franz Joseph and Empress Elisabeth as their summer resort, including Kaiservilla (E). Take some time to enjoy the local culture, shopping and thermal baths. If it is not possible to travel via Bad Ischel, we will instead visit the village of [Hallstatt](#), including a short boat ride on Hallstättersee.

Lunch will be served in a local restaurant along the way. After checking in at the hotel for dinner, enjoy a free evening stroll around town. **OVERNIGHT – INNSBRUCK**

Thursday, September 10: Innsbruck (B)

Enjoy a walking tour through the old town of [Innsbruck](#), including the “golden roof”, most famous landmark of Innsbruck. Also, see the Imperial castle and the cathedral. We travel to the [Bergisel Ski Jump](#) with a great view overlooking Innsbruck. The afternoon and evening are free for lunch and dinner on your own. **OVERNIGHT – INNSBRUCK**

Friday, September 11: Innsbruck to Salzburg (B, D)

We leave Innsbruck for Wattens and the world-famous [Swarovski Crystal World](#) (E), designed by multimedia artist André Heller. Continue to [Kufstein](#), the “Pearl of Tyrol”, featuring a medieval Fortress overlooking the Inn Valley. The local history museum exhibits ice-age arrowheads, showing the area as one of the oldest inhabited in the Tyrol region. After some free time for lunch on your own, we continue to Salzburg for dinner at the hotel. **OVERNIGHT - SALZBURG**

Saturday, September 12: Salzburg, the Sound of Music (B, D)

Discover the beauties of the city of Mozart by walking with a local guide through the UNESCO-protected Old Town of [Salzburg](#). The tour highlights include Mozart's birthplace and residence, the Getreidegasse Cathedral Square or the Mirabell Palace with its magnificent garden. After some free time for lunch on our own, we start “[The Sound of Music](#)” tour, visiting the musical movie's most memorable locations. Aside from the magnificent views of Austria's Lake District, we will also see Mondsee Cathedral and Lake Wolfgang, for a visit to the pilgrimage church with the famous gothic altar. We will say good bye to our friends with a farewell dinner at a local restaurant. **OVERNIGHT - SALZBURG**

Sunday, September 13: Depart Salzburg (B)

For departure, participants may opt to fly back from Salzburg or take a train to Munich or Vienna. No departure transportation services are provided.
