The tour will take place right after Easter and right before Passover. We'll visit Christian and Jewish heritage sites, along with lots of ancient Greek history. The program includes three nights in **Athens** with touring to **Corinth and Delphi**, followed by a 10-night cruise on the Celebrity Infinity, visiting **Thessaloniki, Kavala, Kusadasi (Ephesus), Rhodes and Crete**.

The cruise portion is paid directly to the cruise line while the mainland portion, including the hotels, touring and shore excursions, is paid to Scopia LLC. Interesting sites, great food, unique experiences, lots of time to relax on the cruise and – most importantly – a small group of good friends traveling together!

1. To Register for the Tour:

Registration for the tour is now open via the dedicated, secure form available on the tour website.

The initial deposits are **(a)** \$100 per person for the mainland portion, which can be paid by check or with credit card, and **(b)** \$450 per person paid directly to the cruise line. Deposits are refunded if the minimum of 15 participants (8 cabins) is not reached by October 15, 2026.

Please have the following information/documents available prior to registration:

- Your passport (must be valid for at least 6 months beyond the date of return).
 - **If you do not have a passport or if your passport expires prior to the end of October 2026, please apply for a new passport.**

Seller of Travel: A reminder that Scopia LLC is not registered as a “Seller of Travel” in the states of California, Washington and Iowa. This tour is therefore only offered to residents of the states if another person or organization pays their entire tour costs as a gift or donation.

2. Touring Difficulty – Is This Tour Right for You?

The tour is not sold or offered as ADA-compliant. Aside from the beautiful sites and lots of fun during our travels, there is important information you should consider:

- While touring, you will be boarding and getting off the vehicle several times per day, during touring days.
- **Some of the days will entail several hours of walking on even and uneven pavements or roads, ascend and descend stairs (sometimes without railings), walk up or down hills, or stand in place for 30-60 minutes at a time, while listening to the guide’s explanations.**
- Many of the sites are not designed to accommodate travelers with walking accessories.
- Some of the days may entail drives of 2 hours or longer.
- The vehicle on the tour is not ADA-compliant, but it is air conditioned.
- It is possible to skip touring days and stay in the hotel or on the cruise ship, but there will be no refund for unused touring, meals or entrance fees.
- Sailing on a ship in the Mediterranean likely means some “pitching” (up/down movement) or “rolling” (swaying sideways).
- April weather is usually comfortable (60’s-70’s) during the daytime and cooler evenings (50’s-60’s).
- Food allergies or requirements will be noted and forwarded but may not be properly addressed. It is the responsibility of the participants to be diligent about their food.

This refers to any **airfare** not part of the group reservation, touring and meals not part of the itinerary, drinks during meals, passports, expenses of a personal nature such as gifts, mini-bar purchases or cell phone expenses (calls, data roaming).
- **Flights to Greece: please do not purchase flights until requested to do so.**
- **Travel insurance.**
- **Greece Sustainability Tax – €3 Per person, per port will be added to the cabin bill.**

8. Payment Schedule, Terms and Conditions:

- A. By registering for this tour and/or submitting any payment, you confirm that you have read, understood, and agree to all sections of this brochure, including the Terms and Conditions and the Disclaimer. You further confirm that, if registering or paying on behalf of any other traveler, you are authorized to do so, and that all travelers are bound by these terms.
- B. Mainland tour payments are accepted by check or wire transfer payable to Scopia LLC. Cruise payments are made directly to the cruise line by credit card.
- C. Checks must arrive by the due date and should include "Greece 2027" in the memo line. Address: Scopia LLC, 8916 N. Iroquois Road, Bayside, WI 53217.
- D. **Payment Schedule. Registration Deadline: October 15, 2026:**
 - a. **At Registration and no later than October 15, 2026:** \$100 per person mainland deposit.
 - b. **October 15, 2026:** A deposit of \$450 per person paid to the cruise line by credit card.
 - c. **December 31, 2026:**
 - 1. Final cruise balance is due, paid directly to the cruise line by credit card.
 - 2. Additional \$2,000 deposit is due for the mainland tour by check only.
 - d. **February 15, 2027:** Final payment is due for the mainland portion.
- E. **Cancellation and Refund Policy (if you cancel):** Cancellations must be received **in writing**.
 - a. **Mainland** Portion of the Tour (payments made to Scopia LLC):
 - 1. Cancel by December 31, 2026: \$100 fee per person.
 - 2. Cancel January 1 – February 14, 2027: \$2,000 fee per person.
 - 3. Cancel after February 14, 2027: All payments are non-refundable.
 - b. **Cruise** Portion of the Tour (payments made to Celebrity Cruises):
 - 1. Cancel by December 31, 2026: No penalty.
 - 2. Cancel January 1 – January 17, 2027: 25% is non-refundable.
 - 3. Cancel January 18 – January 31, 2027: 50% is non-refundable.
 - 4. Cancel February 1 – March 2, 2027: 75% is non-refundable.
 - 5. Cancel after March 2, 2027: 100% is non-refundable.
- F. **Cancellation of the tour by Scopia LLC:**
 - a. If the tour is cancelled due to insufficient enrollment, mainland deposit (\$100) is refunded.
 - b. **Force Majeure & Refunds:** If Scopia LLC cancels the tour due to events beyond its reasonable control ("**Force Majeure**"), such as acts of God, war, terrorism, pandemics, or government travel restrictions, Scopia LLC will use diligent efforts to recover funds from third-party Suppliers. Any recovered funds will be returned to participants, less a non-refundable **\$300 administrative fee** per person to cover work already performed.
- G. **Third-Party and Ancillary Expenses:** Scopia LLC is not responsible for any independent expenses, "add-on" services, or ancillary costs incurred by participants in connection with the tour. This includes, but is not limited to, **independently purchased airfare (domestic or international), travel insurance premiums, visa fees, vaccinations, or specialized equipment**. All such expenses are subject strictly to the terms of the specific service providers, and Scopia LLC shall have no liability for refunds or compensation for these external costs.
- H. **Payment schedules and refund amounts are subject to change if required by suppliers.**
- I. There are no refunds for unused services.
- J. Scopia LLC reserves the right to refuse participation or cancel reservations for nonpayment.
- K. Credit card chargebacks do not void these terms. If a chargeback is resolved in favor of Scopia LLC, a \$100 administrative fee will apply. Credit card refunds do not include the 3% processing fee.
