1. To Register for the Tour:

Registration for the tour is now open via the dedicated, secure form available on the tour website.

The upfront pay now costs are \$100 non-refundable deposit per person. It can be paid by check, Zelle or credit card (added fee). This deposit will be refunded if a minimum of 10 participants is not reached by November 30, 2026.

Please have the following information/documents available prior to registration:

- Your passport (must be valid for at least 6 months beyond the date of return).
 - **If you do not have a passport or if your passport expires prior to the end of September 2027, please apply for a new passport.**

Seller of Travel: A reminder that Scopia LLC is not registered as a “Seller of Travel” in the states of California, Washington and Iowa. This tour is therefore not offered to residents of the states.

2. Touring Difficulty – Is This Tour Right for You?

The tour is not sold or offered as ADA-compliant. Aside from the beautiful sites and lots of fun during our travels, there is important information you should consider:

- While touring, you will be boarding and getting off the vehicle several times per day, during touring days.
- **Some of the days will entail several hours of walking on even and uneven pavements or roads, ascend and descend stairs (sometimes without railings), walk up or down hills, or stand in place for 30-60 minutes at a time, while listening to the guide's explanations.**
- Please be sure to [review the brochure](#) detailing the levels of difficulty for each shore excursion.
- Many of the sites are not designed to accommodate travelers with walking accessories.
- Some of the days may entail drives of 2 hours or longer.
- The vehicle on the tour is not ADA-compliant but it is air conditioned.
- It is possible to skip sites and stay in the hotel/cruise, but there will be no refund for unused entrance fees.
- Sailing on a ship in the Mediterranean likely means at least some “pitching” (up/down movement) or “rolling” (swaying sideways).
- March weather is usually comfortable (60's-70's) during the daytime and cooler in the evenings (50's-60's).
- Food allergies or requirements will be noted and forwarded but may not be properly addressed. It is the responsibility of the participants to be diligent about their food.

8. Payment Schedule, Terms and Conditions:

- A. By registering for this tour and/or submitting any payment, you confirm that you have read, understood, and agree to all sections of this brochure, including the Terms and Conditions and the Disclaimer. You further confirm that, if registering or paying on behalf of any other traveler, you are authorized to do so, and that all travelers are bound by these terms.
- B. Payments are accepted by check or wire transfer payable to Scopia LLC.
- C. Checks must arrive by the due date and should include "Greece 0327" in the memo line.

- D. **Important dates to remember:**
 - a. **Upon booking and no later than November 30, 2026:** A non-refundable deposit of \$100 per person (credit card, check or ACH wire transfer).
 - b. **December 1, 2026:** If we reach 10 participants, an additional non-refundable deposit of \$1,000 per person.
 - c. **January 1, 2027:** Final payment is due and is non-refundable.
- E. **Refund periods (if you cancel):**
 - a. Cancel by November 30, 2026: \$100 cancellation fee per person.
 - b. Cancel December 1 – 31, 2026: \$1,000 cancellation fee per person.
 - c. Cancel any time after December 31, 2026: All payments are non-refundable.
- F. **Cancellation of the tour by Scopia LLC:**
 - a. If the tour is cancelled due to insufficient enrollment, initial deposit (\$100) is refunded.
 - b. **Force Majeure & Refunds:** If Scopia LLC cancels the tour due to events beyond its reasonable control ("**Force Majeure**"), such as acts of God, war, terrorism, pandemics, or government travel restrictions, Scopia LLC will use diligent efforts to recover funds from third-party Suppliers.
