You can pay the initial deposit by credit card with an added processing fee, Zelle or send a check. The balance will be due by check, Zelle or wire transfer (ACH) only. 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1. To Register for the Tour:

Registration for the tour is now open via the dedicated, secure form available on the tour website.

The upfront pay now costs are \$100 non-refundable deposit per person (\$200 per person if upgrading your cruise to a category BA cabin or higher). It can be paid by check, Zelle or credit card (added fee).

Please have the following information/documents available prior to registration:

- Your passport: If you do not have a passport or if your passport expires prior to the end of May 2028, you may still register and provide your new passport details later.

Seller of Travel: Before registering for the tour, please note Scopia LLC is not registered as a "Seller of Travel" in the states of CA, WA and HI and therefore unable to welcome aboard participants who are residents of these states, unless the tour is paid for in full, as a gift or donation, by someone residing outside of these states.

2. Touring Difficulty – Is This Tour Right for You?

The tour is not sold or offered as ADA-compliant. Aside from the beautiful sites and lots of fun during our travels, there is important information you should consider:

- While touring, you will be boarding and getting off the vehicle several times per day.
- **Some of the days will entail several hours of walking on even and uneven pavements or roads, ascend and descend stairs (sometimes without railings), walk up or down hills, or stand in place for 30-60 minutes at a time, while listening to the guide's explanations.**
- Many of the sites are not designed to accommodate travelers with walking accessories.
- Some of the days may entail drives of 2 hours or longer.
- The vehicle on the tour is not ADA-compliant but it is air conditioned.
- It is possible to skip sites and stay in the hotel/cruise, but there will be no refund for unused entrance fees.
- Sailing on a ship in the Mediterranean likely means at least some “pitching” (up/down movement) or “rolling” (swaying sideways).
- November weather is usually comfortable (60's-70's) during the daytime and cooler in the evenings (50's-60's). Rain is likely on occasion and it can get quite cold and windy on the ships outside decks in the evening.
- Food allergies or requirements will be noted and forwarded but may not be properly addressed. It is the responsibility of the participants to be diligent about their food.

7. Not Included in the Tour Cost:

- Any service not mentioned above as included in the tour costs, is not included. This refers, but is not limited to, **international flights US to Thessaloniki and return from Athens**, meals not mentioned as included, drinks during included meals, touring outside of the itinerary, passport fees, visas or [ETIAS](#) if needed, expenses of a personal nature such as gifts, mini-bar purchases, laundry or phone/data expenses.

8. Payment Schedule, Terms and Conditions:

- A. By registering for this tour and/or submitting any payment, you confirm that you have read, understood, and agree to all sections of this brochure, including the Terms and Conditions and the Disclaimer. You further confirm that, if registering or paying on behalf of any other traveler, you are authorized to do so, and that all travelers are bound by these terms.
- B. Payments are accepted by check or wire transfer payable to Scopia LLC.
- C. Checks must arrive by the due date and should include "Lapka Greece 2027" in the memo line. Address: Scopia LLC, 8916 N. Iroquois Road, Bayside, WI 53217.
- D. **Important dates to remember:**
 - a. **Upon booking and no later than January 31, 2027:** A non-refundable deposit of \$100 per person (credit card, check or ACH wire transfer).
 - 1. Initial deposit will be \$200 per person if cruise cab in category is BA or higher.
 - b. **February 1, 2027:** An additional, non-refundable deposit of \$600 per person is due.
 - c. **July 1, 2027:** An additional, non-refundable deposit of \$1,000 per person is due.
 - d. **September 1, 2027:** Final payment is due and is non-refundable.
- E. **Refund periods (if you cancel):**
 - a. Cancel by January 31, 2027: \$100 cancellation fee per person.
 - b. Cancel between February 1 – June 30, 2027: \$700 cancellation fee per person.
 - c. Cancel between June 30 – August 31, 2027: \$1,700 cancellation fee per person.
 - d. Cancel any time after August 31, 2027: All payments are non-refundable.
- F. **Cancellation of the tour by Scopia LLC:**
 - a. If tour is cancelled for insufficient enrollment, the initial deposit (\$100) is refunded.
 - b. **Force Majeure & Refunds:** If Scopia LLC cancels the tour due to events beyond its reasonable control ("**Force Majeure**"), such as acts of God, war, terrorism, pandemics, or government travel restrictions, Scopia LLC will use diligent efforts to recover funds from third-party Suppliers. Any recovered funds will be returned to participants, less a non-refundable **\$300 administrative fee** per person to cover work already performed.

9. Flights:

So that participants may purchase tickets on any airline of their choice, flights are not included in the tour costs. When requested, you can purchase tickets yourself or with the help of Scopia LLC, departing the US for Thessaloniki (SKG) November 6 and returning from Athens (ATH) to the US November 16.

Private airport transfers are included in the tour costs. If there are several people arriving or departing on the same flights, airport transfers will be combined.
