### 1. Touring Difficulty – Is This Tour Right for You?

The tour is not sold or offered as ADA-compliant. Aside from the beautiful sites and lots of fun on the tour, there is important information you should consider:

- Although portage service will be provided, you may need to carry your luggage on occasion.
- Some of the days will entail **bus rides of 2-4 hours** (planned bathroom breaks).
- You will be boarding and getting off the bus 4-6 times per day, during touring days.
- Some of the days will entail several hours of walking on even and uneven pavements or roads, ascending and descending stairs (without railings), walking up or down hills, or standing in place for 20-30 minutes at a time, while listening to the guide’s explanations.
- Many of the sites are not designed to accommodate travelers with walking accessories.
- The buses on the tour are not ADA-compliant and may not have bathrooms.
- It is possible to skip sites and stay in the hotel, with no refund for unused entrance fees.
- Temperatures will likely be in the 60’s-70’s during the daytime, depending on location. Evenings will likely be in the 50’s. It may be colder in mountains areas, along with rain on occasion.
- Do not drink tap water and avoid uncooked/unpeeled fruits and vegetables.
- Smoking is allowed indoors (such as in hotel lobbies).
- Souvenir peddlers at tourist sites can be intimidating. Learn to say “no”.
- Food allergies will be noted and forwarded but may not be properly addressed.
- Medical facilities in Morocco are available in large cities but limited in remote areas.

## 2. To Register for the Tour:

Registration for the tour is now open via the dedicated, secure form available on the tour website.

The upfront pay now costs are \$100 non-refundable deposit per person. It can be paid by check or by credit card (with a fee). This deposit will be refunded if a minimum of 10 participants is not reached by August 1, 2026.

**Please have the following information/documents available prior to registration:**

- Your passport (must be valid for at least 6 months beyond the date of return).
  - **If you do not have a passport or if your passport expires prior to May 31, 2027, please apply for a new passport.**

**Seller of Travel:** A reminder that Scopia LLC is **not** registered as a “Seller of Travel” in the states of California, Washington and Iowa. This tour is therefore not offered to residents of the states unless the tour is fully paid for as a gift by someone from another state.

## 3. Tour Costs:

As you can see from the chart above, the tour cost per person drops by \$100 per person if we reach 15 participants. So be sure to invite friends and family!

**Note that airfare is not included in the tour costs.** Scopia LLC can help you book your flights, or you can book them on your own. Please do not book your flights until requested to do so (when we reach 10 registered participants).

## 4. Included in the Tour Cost:

- **Hotels – 8 Nights:**

  - Nov 07 - 11: 4 Nights [Riad La Maison Arabe](#) or [Riad Elegancia](#) – Marrakesh
- **Transportation and Touring:**
  - Group airport transfers on arrival (Tangier)
    - Private airport transfers for departure (Marrakech).
  - 7 Full days of touring with a local guide and bus.
  - All entrance fees to sites and meals mentioned in the itinerary
  - 2 Bottles of water on the bus, per participant, per day of touring.
- **19 Meals:**
  - 8 Breakfasts (daily) at all hotels.

## 5. Not Included in the Tour Cost:

- Generally speaking: Anything not mentioned in the “Tour Cost Includes” portion above is not included. This refers to any flights, touring and meals not part of the itinerary, drinks during meals (except for water), passports, expenses of a personal nature such as gifts, mini-bar purchases or cell phone expenses (calls, data roaming, etc.).
- **Any transportation in the US.**
- **Flights from the US to Morocco (US to Tangier and Marrakech to the US).**
- **Any expenses related to COVID (testing or otherwise).**
- **Travel insurance.**

## 7. Travel Insurance:

## 8. Payment Schedule, Terms and Conditions:

- A. By registering for this tour and/or submitting any payment, you confirm that you have read, understood, and agree to all sections of this brochure, including the Terms and Conditions and the Disclaimer. You further confirm that, if registering or paying on behalf of any other traveler, you are authorized to do so, and that all travelers are bound by these terms.
- B. Payments are accepted by check or wire transfer payable to Scopia LLC.
- C. Checks must arrive by the due date and should include "Morocco 2027" in the memo line. Address: Scopia LLC, 8916 N. Iroquois Road, Bayside, WI 53217.
- D. Important dates to remember:**
  - a. **Registration Deadline:** August 1, 2026
  - b. **At Registration and no later than August 1, 1026:** A non-refundable deposit of \$100 per person (credit card or check).
  - c. **August 1, 2026:** If we reach 10 participants, a second non-refundable deposit of \$2,000 per person is due and is non-refundable (check or ACH).
  - d. **September 15, 2026:** Final payment is due and is non-refundable (check or ACH).
- E. Refund periods (if you cancel):**
  - a. Cancel by August 1, 2026: \$100 cancellation fee per person.
  - b. Cancel from August 1, 2026 - September 15, 2026: \$2,100 cancellation fee per person.
  - c. Cancel any time after September 15, 2026: All payments are non-refundable.
- F. Cancellation of the tour by Scopia LLC:**
  - a. If the tour is cancelled due to insufficient enrollment, mainland deposit (\$100) is refunded.
  - b. **Force Majeure & Refunds:** If Scopia LLC cancels the tour due to events beyond its reasonable control ("**Force Majeure**"), such as acts of God, war, terrorism, pandemics, or government travel restrictions, Scopia LLC will use diligent efforts to recover funds from third-party Suppliers. Any recovered funds will be returned to participants, less a non-refundable **\$300 administrative fee** per person to cover work already performed.
- G. Third-Party and Ancillary Expenses:** Scopia LLC is not responsible for any independent expenses, "add-on" services, or ancillary costs incurred by participants in connection with the tour. This includes, but is not limited to, **independently purchased airfare (domestic or international), travel insurance premiums, visa fees, vaccinations, or specialized equipment**. All such expenses are subject strictly to the terms of the specific service providers, and Scopia LLC shall have no liability for refunds or compensation for these external costs.
- H. **Payment schedules and refund amounts are subject to change if required by suppliers.**
- I. There are no refunds for unused services.
- J. Scopia LLC reserves the right to refuse participation or cancel reservations for nonpayment.
- K. Credit card chargebacks do not void these terms. If a chargeback is resolved in favor of Scopia LLC, a \$100 administrative fee will apply. Credit card refunds do not include the 3% processing fee.
- L. Credit card refunds do not include the 3% agency processing fee.
- M. Rate Calculations: All rates are subject to correction and change until final payment is received.

## 9. Flight Itinerary:

Flights are not included in the tour costs. You can book your own flights or Scopia LLC can book your flights for you. Please do not book your flights before requested to do so (when we reach 10 participants).

Flights should be booked for November 2 from the US to Tangier (TNG) and returning November 11 from Marrakech (RAK) to the US. Most convenient options are with Air France and/or Delta.
